

Mick Hawken: Senior Coach 2003

The Club has appointed Mick Hawken, as its Senior Coach for this year.

Mick played his junior football at Ferntree Gully and was a founding member of the Boronia Park in 1989 and also a member of their Premiership side in their first year.

Mick went onto be Senior Coach at the club when it was in the Southern Football League and then with us in the YVMDFL, but unfortunately the club was not able to survive. Mick also was Assistant Coach at Forest Hill Football in the Eastern Football League.

I asked Mick how pre-season had gone and he stated.



"I will be honest and say that numbers on the track are not what I would have liked but each week there have been signs of improvement. Our practice match against Seville was very pleasing and encouraging, we only just got beaten near the end. Our recruiting has been good and we have secured 2-3 quality key position players. Also some positive signs from our younger players who have come through our junior ranks and a couple who I expect to jump to that next level this year. I have concentrated our pre-season revolving around our game plan and skills work we have used the footys a lot. I believe that this year is a very important year for the Emerald Football Club in the lead up to our centenary year, I go into this year very positive and we have set goals to be part of the finals this year."

To All Players

Registration:

All players must be registered to play. Registration covers, among other things, medical insurance in case of injury or accident. Registration fees in 2003 are:

Senior / single player: \$150

Player / Family: \$180 (player + wife/ player + parents)

Family social: \$110 (up to 2 adults plus children under 16)

Under 18 single: \$60Under 18 & family: \$130

Please pay ASAP. A registration / membership card will be issued on payment to the Club-see Phil Gluckman (Treasurer). The membership card gives you free admission to our home games.

Insurance:

Registration provides medical and accident insurance for players involved with playing or training. It covers non medicare cover to \$2,5000 with \$75 excess covering 75% of the non Medicare claim. Claim forms are available from Phil Gluckman (Treasurer) - so if you get injured remember you may be able to claim.

Entry to ground:

You must produce your membership card to gain free entry to home games (you get a membership card when you pay your registration fee). All players pay to get into away games.

Roster:

A roster for the Club's canteen will be put in place. All players will be rostered on. It is your responsibility to fill your roster - if you can't do it at your allocated time, you must organise someone to fill your spot (eg parent, girlfriend, etc)

Uniform:

Players need to get black shorts & white shorts, and red & black socks. The club will provide the jumpers & the club will organise the washing of the jumpers after a match. To purchase shorts & socks - we suggest you go to Peter Warren's store in Emerald "Warren Sports" just opposite the junior ground.

Training:

Tues / Thursday from 6:15pm. If you can't make training, call coach Mick Hawkin on 0418 540 677. After Thursday night training, the side will be announced. We ask that all players stay around for the reading of the sides.

After Games:

Players are asked to be at the clubrooms by 6pm after each match (both home & away) for the presentation of game awards. Awards should be completed by 6:30pm approx.

Functions:

A range of social functions are organised during the year, eg EFC Ball. Players are expected to attend.

<u>Volunteers</u>: The Club relies on the help of a small number of dedicated volunteers. Please help out when asked and if you would like to, there are a number of things you can help us with around the club.




