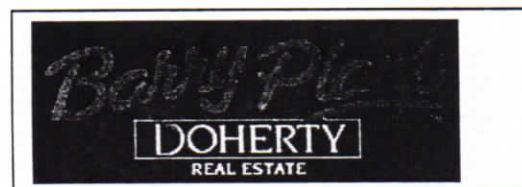

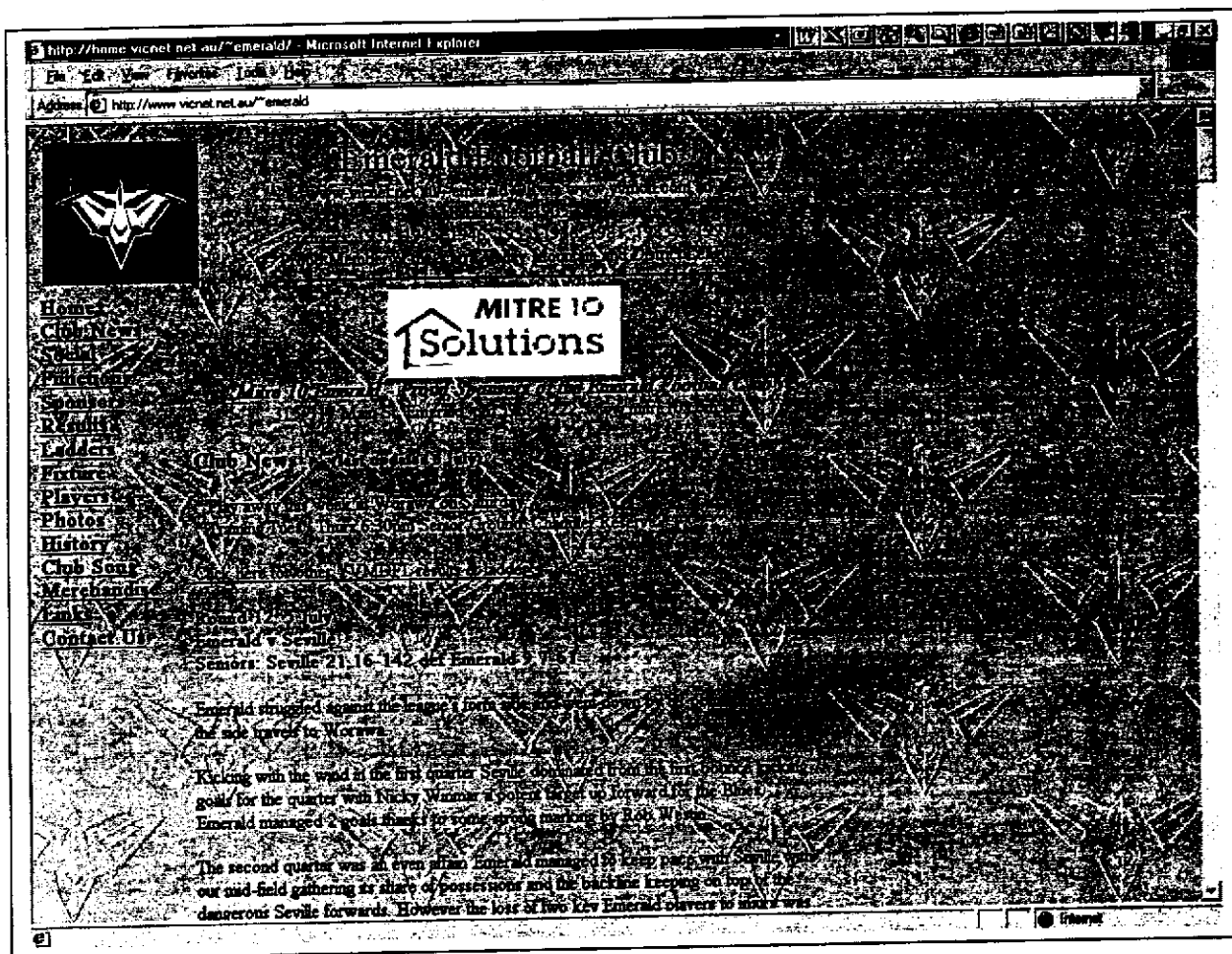

Emerald struggled against the league's form side and went down by 81 points. Next week the side travels to Worawa.

Kicking with the wind in the first quarter Seville dominated from the first bounce kicking 7 goals for the quarter with Nicky Winmar a potent target up forward for the Blues. Emerald managed 2 goals thanks to some strong marking by Rob Westin.

The second quarter was an even affair. Emerald managed to keep pace with Seville with our mid-field gathering its share of possessions and the backline keeping on top of the dangerous Seville forwards. However the loss of two key Emerald players to injury was going to make it hard for the Bombers. At the long break the difference was 39 points.

The Bombers started the third quarter on fire kicking the first two goals. Josh Conder's goal from the boundary line was a real beauty. But just as Emerald was looking to work its way back into the match, Seville took control and kicked away again.

The last quarter saw Seville's big men and forwards dominate against an undermanned Emerald outfit to run out convincing winners. Ben O'Donnell's goal kicked while brushing aside a tackle from the boundary line was a highlight of the quarter.

For Emerald, Clinton Marsh played a classy game and his gutsy mark running back with the flight of the ball in the second quarter was real highlight. The forwards made the most of their opportunities. Rob Westin kicked three goals, Ben O'Donnell and Josh Conder kicked two goals.

Simon Bergin battled valiantly in the ruck. Paul McKenzie got plenty of the ball. Wes Wright and Peter McLean worked hard in the mid-field. Andrew Rolfs, Daniel Del Santo and Shane Bryant played well despite having to play both in the seniors and reserves due to lack of numbers.
