
The Bombers started the third quarter on fire kicking the first two goals. Josh Conder's goal


from the boundary line was a real beauty. But just as Emerald was looking to work its way back into the match, Seville took control and kicked away again.




Some supporters went for grub, Down the road to the Launching Place Pub!
