

Presidents Report:

13 August 2005

Firstly, I would like to welcome Warburton Millgrove Under 18's and Powelltown Football Clubs to today's games and I hope everyone has an enjoyable day.

I would like to thank all players and supporters who attended our annual ball on Saturday 30 July. This was our major function for the season and I do believe everyone who attended had a great time. I must congratulate all in attendance, on the efforts everyone went to, in dressing up and joining in with the fun of the night. Great support was shown, in particular by our senior players.

Sadly, with every high there has to be a low and the low for me, was the non attendance of players and supporters who said they would be there and did not front or give an excuse. We catered for these people and it is both wasteful and expensive to cater for non attendance.

Secondly, for us to go forward and survive we must have support from everyone within the club and it was extremely disappointing to me and the organizers of the function that no support at all was seen from our Under 18 side, with the exception of Kelly and Rowan Pascoe and Dayna Russell. The club has outlaid over \$7000.00 this year to field an Under 18 side in this competition and we have not asked for a single cent from these players or parents to cover jumpers, shorts, socks, registration and insurance.

The aim of these functions is to enjoy ourselves and raise much needed funds for the club. Having the additional people attending, would have helped a long way towards recuperating costs.

Thirdly, we have 77 players registered with the club, 49 senior and 28 under 18's and only 9 players made the effort to seek player sponsorship, which is something we asked all players to do at the beginning of the season.

With the lack of support to date, we find ourselves behind the eight ball and are finding things extremely difficult and embarrassing, to honor our debts both to the League and the suppliers of goods to the Emerald Football Club.

Emerald is a proud Club with a history of more than 100 years and unless supporters of this club come forward and support our club, we may not be here for very much longer.

A number of people have dreams for our Club, such as extensions to the clubrooms, promotion to First Division and having high profile players, but none of these dreams will come to fruition, unless parents, players and supporters get behind the club, make a commitment and follow these commitments through. If you are not prepared to do this and leave it for the same few, then there may not be a season 2007!

The decision is yours to think about!
