**Final Score:** Yarra Junction 13-9-87 def Emerald 4-5-29

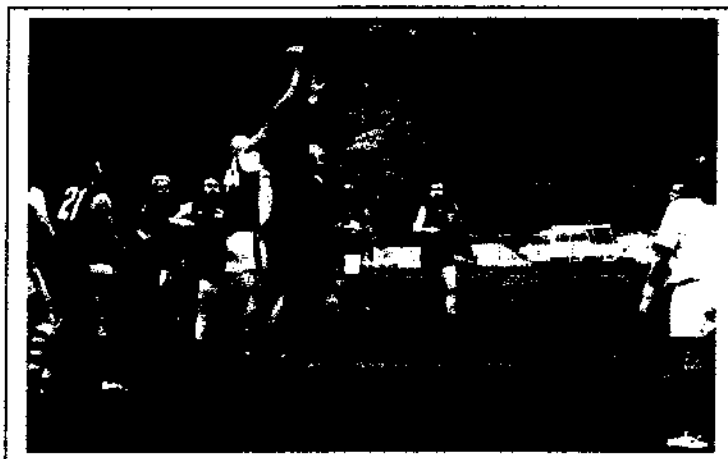
### Reserves

Today's game against Yarra Glen was a reverse of last week's performance. The girls played extremely well defeating Yarra Glen 52 to 9.

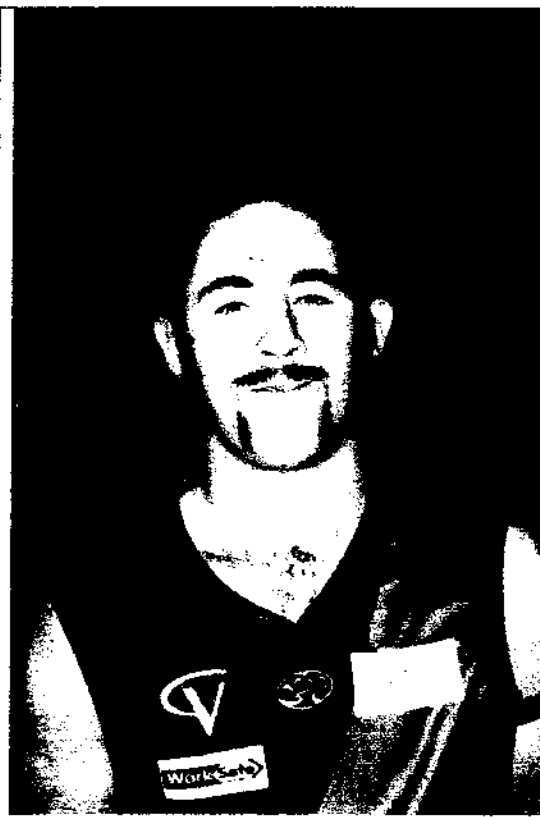
With only 7 players, our team worked hard to keep Emerald in the lead.
