

Goals Scored: Rod Smith 5 and one each to Clinton Marsh and Robbie Stewart.


Final Score: Yarra Junction 29-18-192 def Emerald 7-8-50

Most valuable players for Emerald were Kate Griffith, Bev White, Hayley White and Fiona Grunter.






