

Emerald reverses first round loss to Yea and stops Yea's finals run.

Emerald started strong kicking the first four goals, before Yea troubled the scoreboard. Emerald had ten scoring shoots, to Yea's two, to lead by twenty-eight points at quarter time

Yea fought back in the second quarter and dominated this quarter and got back to within four points at half time.
