

Young Bombers steal a famous victory at the death against inaccurate Mt Evelyn.


We are six rounds into the 2013 season and the Bombers sit a respectable 3 wins and 3 losses.

#### "News Update- May-June 2013"

Great news has just been received from Cardinia Shire, in the form of commitments to firstly, the oval and secondly, the pavilion.

Firstly, the Shire has committed \$500,000, in this year's budget, for the renovation of the oval. This means the oval will be closed as of the end of the football season, or when the ground becomes unplayable, whichever comes first. The oval will be levelled out, with new drainage, watering system and new grass to cater for the harsh winters, experienced in the Emerald district.

The works are expected to commence around September 2013 and the oval will be ready for use, starting season 2015.

This is great news, as the playing surface has been an embarrassment and a safety issue for players.

Secondly, and this is what the Emerald Sporting Club has been striving for, is the progress of the upgrading, extension, refurbishment, whatever you want to call it, of the clubrooms.

The Emerald Sporting Club Committee, has had a meeting with the Cardinia Shire CEO, Sports and Recreation Manager and Building and Construction Manager.

Our proposal was presented at the meeting and it soon became apparent, that with regulation changes and changes to disabled policies, our proposal fell short of requirements. An example of this is the new requirements for disabled access to second stories. We can no longer drive, or transport to a distant area, we must now supply access from the viewing areas downstairs. This means a lift between floors, at an additional, sizeable cost.

The whole project seemed to have become too expensive and difficult, when the Shire CEO stepped in and made a couple of commitments.

The first commitment is to have Cardinia Shire personnel produce the required drawings, computations and soil test, in readiness for the commencement of the building. These drawings will be completed by the end of July, 2013. We have already seen Shire personnel at the clubrooms measuring up and inspecting the conditions of the current facilities.



The second commitment was that Cardinia Shire is going to follow up various funds available and budget for next year's planned commencement of the new facilities. These facilities will be state of the art and comply with Health, Safety and Disability regulations.

The building works should be completed in time with the opening of the newly renovated, playing arena.

This has been brilliant news for our community and has only been able to happen because of the backing of supporters, who have committed to become Foundation Members and Sponsors who believe that this is a critical project for the Community.

The Shire personnel were also most impressed with the commitment everyone has made and this in turn, has also seen the fantastic support from our Ranges Ward Counsellors, Leticia Wilmot and Tania Baxter and Cr. Brett Owen.

We have also seen great support from our local State Minister, Brad Batten, as well as our pre-selection, Liberal Candidate for the Federal Government, Jason Wood. This project has been very well communicated and flagged from Local, to State and Federal Governments. Our continual persistence with all these people is now starting to pay off.

With all this great news, we still have to meet our commitments of having \$200,000, in our Bendigo Bank accounts. This means that people, who have pledged to come on board as Foundation Members, must be fully paid by the 30th June, 2013.

We still have a few Foundation Memberships on offer, however our original 130 memberships still stands, and will work on a first in basis.
