	MEDAL COUNT/AWARDS
	L Promnitz commenced discussion regarding the above and suggested not to have the actual count/presentation day due to restrictions, but the count could take place via livestream. The proposed date also again falls on Fathers Day, and it would be likely that some clubs may not attend, but moving into next season West Augusta would host the day in lieu of this year. M Foote suggested that Under 18's, B and A Grade could be counted during the livestream due to the shortened season and clubs could arrange their own gatherings.
	Discussion regarding timing of the livestream also took place, and it was agreed to occur at 3.00pm on 06/09/2020.
