GROUND UPDATE

On Friday 10th July the Labor Member for Western Victoria, Jalla Pulford MP announced that the Mininera Recreation Reserve Football Oval was successful in receiving a \$115,000 grant in conjunction with the Ararat Rural City Council who are also contributing around \$45,000 for the installation of a new automated irrigation system and oval resurfacing, the installation of a water tank and electrical upgrade and the resurfacing of the oval with a climatically resilient couch-rye mix.

We thank the Ararat Rural City Council for financing this project and we can't wait for sport to return to Mininera in the near future!


