His 2019 rowing season included 4 South Island Championship gold medals, Gold and Silver at The New Zealand Club Championships and 4 National golds at the MAADI Cup, including the Under 18 Eights, which carried a prize of a new single sculls boat for his school, Christchurch Boys High School.

His record in rowing has been outstanding over his 3 years in secondary school and under age local, South Island and National competitions and culminated in his receiving the following awards:

Canterbury Rowing Association – Canterbury Secondary School Boy of the Year 2019  
Canterbury Rowing Club – Canterbury School Boy of the Year 2019  
Canterbury Rowing Club – Rower of the Year 2019.

He has also been contacted by 2 prestigious Rowing Colleges in USA – Princeton and Harvard.
