FROM THE SENIOR COACH



Hi all, that would have to be the quietest month of May we have ever had in a football season, thankfully that is now behind us and we can move on into June where we commence group training in squads of twenty and can include contact training into our sessions. This does not sound that exciting but when you are trying to work with groups of ten without contact in May to what we have now it is a huge improvement. Hopefully we can get fast tracked into full squad training soon which is our last transition phase into preparing to play our Season 2020.

With footy news at a premium at the moment I thought I would take the opportunity to introduce my coaching group and explain how the Fabulous Four got to be together working with me at Myponga Sellicks in 2020.

Bill Matheson – A grade Assistant Coach – Boundary Line Coach and Forwards Coach – Bill is a passionate coach that loves competition whose biggest strength is how he can read the game and the players. He will often make a call on the direction of a game before it happens and can assess players very quickly. Bill and I have been mates since we were fifteen years old, a lot has changed since then (including Bill losing his mullet hair cut) and we went our different ways in life. We ended up meeting again via my neighbour who is in the agriculture industry, as is Bill. After no contact for thirty years Bill had moved into the next suburb and I immediately recruited him to the Flagstaff Hill FC as an Assistant Coach with me in our 2013 B grade flag and then into the Senior Football Director role in the A grade premiership run which commenced in 2016. Kym Dooley - B Grade Coach - Dools as we all know him has been a mate of mine for nearly twenty years. We played cricket together in a very successful period at the Happy Valley Cricket Club and then involved at the Happy Valley footy club together. I then recruited him to come over to Flagstaff Hill with me when I started coaching the B grade there. We needed an enforcer and Dools was the man. He ended up playing in the B grade premiership team and then went on to coaching the B grade working with his Dad to guide the team to another B grade flag in 2018. Dools is a great footy person and has had a stint at Myponga as a player back when he was playing good A grade football. I was delighted when he put his hand up to join me this season as he knows the game plan and structures plus is very aligned to my coaching principles based on discipline, structure and education. Dools will be involved with the A grade squad when able as he is very busy with his family who you will all get to meet with one of his lads, Kobe, putting his hand up to come and play Colts with us this season. Dools is a great fit at the club this season and will fast track the young B grade group we have and keep the "more experienced" guys on their toes. Justin Richardson - B Grade Assistant Coach/ A Grade Stats and Technology. - Justin or Richo to the masses is the jack of all trades and master of many. I came across him at the Flagstaff Hill FC when he turned out to train to play C grade. It soon become evident that he may have been a good player in his day but unfortunately at that stage he only had the passion and determination left with the other areas of his game falling away. I soon recognised when I took on the A grade role at Flaggy that I needed someone to assist me who was great with technology if I was to introduce new ideas into the club such as the use of video footage, GPS units, electronic team stats, drones filming and electronic magnet boards to manage player rotations. Richo was my new main man and he took on these challenges with great success to the point we lifted the footy club into a new level of professionalism that I truly believe was key to the success we had at that club and the ongoing success after we left. Richo will be a great right hand man for Dools and then jump into the box for the A grade game looking after the team stats on an iPad and holding Brett's hand to ensure his data is being compiled and managed correctly. Richo will also be coordinating the issue of the GPS units to the players and then providing the updated data to my iPad during the game for instant analysis of our players workloads including distance run, top speed, efforts and impacts plus heat maps so we can manage their running patterns. Richo has been a great help with the Covid 19 requirements which showcased his ability to get it done. Richo is a family man with a young family and an Operational Manager at a national level for a large transport company. Richo does not like sleep......
