BUSINESS PARTNERSHIP AWARDS FOR JUNIOR SPORTS MEN and WOMEN

The following are the guidelines for this award.

1. Award to be made bi-annually in September and March, subject to funding. Applications to close on 31 December and 30 June. The Award to be presented by the naming sponsors at a time and place to be arranged.
2. Proposed Recipient - A Canterbury based junior sports person (under 19 years at 31 December / 30 June of year of application) who has shown potential and requires special assistance to develop further.
3. Purpose - to assist with costs of additional coaching and development to achieve a higher standard and benefit the individual. There must be no implication of personal financial gain. Please specify the intended use for the funds.
4. Must have endorsement of regional body.
5. Must be nominated by a member - Individual, Corporate, Club, Association or School. If supporting more than one nomination per round, please specify order of preference.
6. The Award is a cash payment and a permanent trophy. The amount is subject to funds available from both the Foundation and Business Partner, but should not be less than \$2,000.
7. A report on the benefits obtained from the award may be required.
8. The recipient to be available for publicity in relation to the award.
9. The recipient will be selected by a sub-committee of the Foundation appointed for this purpose.
10. Each application will be considered on its merits. The decision of the selection committee is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
