

# Yorke Valley Basketball Association COVID SAFE – Return to Play

#### **GROUP LIMITS**

- Group limits may vary between stadiums
- Limits will be subject to the 1 person per 2 square metre rules
- Refer to the Copper Coast Sport and Leisure Centre (CCSLC) COVID Safe Plan for further information
- Groups are required to have **two (2) supervising adults** (e.g. coach, team manager, parent), **not included** in the maximum people per court limit
- Parents/caregivers are permitted for supervision purposes BUT must be included in the maximum venue limit.
- It is recommended, where practical, spectators or parents/caregivers are limited to one per participant
- Parents/caregivers in attendance must adhere to social distancing
- Any coach, team official, or player showing any flu-like symptoms or COVID-like symptoms, are required to self-isolate and not attend any training sessions or games during this time.

## **TEAM INTERACTIONS**

- Please use the designated entrances and exits at CCSLC
- Follow all directions and signage for movements within the CCSLC
- Players must arrive no more than 10 minutes prior to their training and/or game commencing
- Teams will not be permitted to enter the stadium until the previous teams have vacated
- Avoid any unnecessary contact e.g. no high fives or handshakes
- Please follow the advice from CCSLC regarding changeroom facilities
- Where possible, maintain distance of 1.5m
- Coaches and parents/caregivers in attendance should maintain distance of at least 1.5m from participants
- Sharing of basketballs during warm-ups and training is permitted, providing all participants sanitise their hands and basketballs before and after each session
- No sharing of drink bottles, food snacks (e.g. lollies or fruit), towels, or other personal items
- All personal belongings must be kept in the designated areas, 1.5 metres apart from other's belongings
- Players, coaches, and officials are required to immediately leave the court area at the conclusion of their game
- YVBA will provide game balls for each court, which are required to be sanitised before the first game, between each game and at the end of the last game of the evening before being put away
- Score benches, player seating and equipment is required to be sanitised before the first game, between each game and at the end of the last game of the evening

## **EQUIPMENT**

- Participants must supply their own drink bottles and towel, clearly labelled
- YVBA will provide game balls for each court, which are required to be sanitised before the first game, between each game and at the end of the last game of the evening before being put away
- Score benches, player seating and equipment is required to be sanitised before the first game, between each game and at the end of the last game of the evening

# **VENUE REQUIREMENTS**

- Participants must follow directions of the Biosafety Officer, stadium staff and venue signage at all times
- All activity providers are required to complete the SA Government **COVID-Safe Plan** for each venue (including outdoor facilities) and implemented guidelines included
- Hand sanitiser will be available at each score bench
- Remember physical distancing when occupying public seating.
- Venues may consider marking or moving seating to comply with social distancing
- Each venue is required to display current COVID-19 signage
- Canteens can be open for snack or hand-held food, adhering to social distancing measures

#### **HYGIENE PRACTICES**

- To assist with contact tracing, clubs may consider encouraging members to download the COVIDSafe App
- Coaches are required to keep active records for each training session or game (which should include and parents/caregivers who have been present)
- Clubs are required to ensure each team has access to hand sanitiser and disinfectant wipes
- Hand sanitiser is to be used by all participants before and after each training session and game
- Basketballs must be sanitised before and after each training session and game under coach/official/COVID Marshal supervision
- Score benches, equipment and team seating must be sanitised before and after each training session and game under coach/official/COVID Marshal supervision
