



# BAROSSA SETTLERS JUNIOR TOURNAMENT

## NOVEMBER 21 & 22, 2020

Barossa Basketball wishes to advise that, all being well, and under the current COVID-19 restrictions, the 2020 Barossa Settlers Junior Basketball Tournament will be held over the weekend of:

**SATURDAY 21st NOVEMBER & SUNDAY 22nd NOVEMBER 2020**

and we invite you to consider participating in our event this year and the tournament will cater for under 10, 12, 14, 16 & 18 boys and girls, Division 1 & 2.

*\*\* Division 3 **MAY** be made available for under 12, 14 & 16 – but will be for 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> teams only – Association's '1<sup>st</sup>' teams will not be accepted into any Division 3 competition!*

Dependant on the number of nominations we anticipate starting early Saturday morning (perhaps 7.30am) and finishing late Sunday afternoon (6.00pm). All teams must be available to play their first game no later than 10:00am Saturday.

*There may be the chance to play some round 1 games on the Friday night at certain stadiums, so if your team would be able to do this, please advise when nominating!*

Dependant on the number of teams entered, games will comprise of either, 4 x 8 minute quarters or 2 x 18 minutes halves (to be advised after nominations have closed), but in all grades, all teams will play a minimum of 4 games for the weekend.

Team Nomination Fees are \$290.00 per team, with a qualified referee.

Team Nomination Fees are \$400.00 per team, without a referee.

We are asking each team nominating to supply a referee or pay the increased nomination fee. If you have referees who would like to attend then please forward their contact details to be included in the referee's roster.

Referee payments for matches will be advised – but the BVABA are pleased to announce that ConnectRef (Jarrod Cresp) will again be overseeing the referees in 2020.

**REFEREES:** If you are wishing to attend the SA Country Cup in January, or SA Country Champs in March, referee coaches will be at this tournament to ref coach your games and provide feedback.

# **BAROSSA SETTLERS JUNIOR TOURNAMENT**

## **Planned playing conditions & tournament rules.**

***Team officials are advised to read thoroughly the following RULES and make certain that their coaches/players are thoroughly conversant with the Rules. Additional copies of the rules can be obtained on request.***

No nomination of teams for the Tournament will be accepted without the appropriate entry fee being paid.  
***If paying on arrival, please pre-organise this with the Tournament Secretary, Graham Catto.***

### PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible a player must be born in the following years:

- Under 10 players must be born 2012 or later
- Under 12 players must be born 2010 or later
- Under 14 players must be born 2008 or later
- Under 16 players must be born 2006 or later
- Under 18 players must be born 2004 or later

A maximum of 10 players per team.

A player may play in only 1 team in the Tournament.

To be eligible to play in finals, a player must play at least two minor round games (there will be at least 3 minor round games per team).

The results of games in which teams play ineligible players will be forfeits.

**TIMING RULES & dependant on teams entered** (ALL minor round and finals games, except grand finals)

#### **50 minute timeslots**

4 x 8 minute quarters  
Championship timing in final 2 minutes (unless a 20 point spread)  
Quarter and three quarter time breaks of 1 minute  
Half time break of 2 minutes,  
Time outs as per FIBA rules.  
Clock will **NOT** stop for time outs, unless in the final 2 minutes  
Overtime (finals only) 2 minutes fully timed, 1 timeout each team

#### **45 minute timeslots**

2 x 18 minute halves, with a running clock  
Championship timing in final minute (unless a 20 point spread)  
Half time break of 2 minutes  
1 time out per team per half  
Clock will **NOT** stop for time outs, unless in the final minute  
Overtime (finals only) 2 minutes fully timed, 1 timeout each team

***Grand Finals – as per 50 minute timing, but in 1 hour timeslots. Overtime, if needed, will be 3 minute periods, 1 time out per team and Championship timing in the last one (1) minute only, for each overtime period needed.***

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to change the above timing rules during the Tournament.

### PREMIERSHIP POINTS, LADDERS AND POSITIONS

Premiership points shall be 3 for a win, 2 for a draw (minor round), and 1 for a loss, forfeit received 3, forfeit given 0.

Forfeits shall count as a 20 - 0 loss to the team forfeiting and a 20 - 0 win to the opposing team.

Drawn games will remain in all minor rounds, overtime rules will apply in finals

In the case of a tie for final position, total percentage will decide.

Any team not present on the court at the scheduled starting time shall be penalised two points for each minute, or part thereof, that the team is late. Any team more than ten minutes late (1/4 time) shall forfeit the match concerned.

### THREE POINT LINE, FOUL LINE AND NO CHARGE ZONE

The three point line will apply for U14, U16 & U18 games.

3.7 metre foul line will be used for all U10 & U12 games.

The “no charge” zone rule will apply on courts thus marked

## TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

Each team must provide a competent scorer or time keeper for each entire game in which that team plays. Each player must wear their teams nominated uniform, incorrectly dressed players will not be permitted to enter the court.

**In the case of a uniform clash the second listed team will be required to wear an alternative strip**

All teams are required to provide their own first aid needs

The match ball for the game will be chosen by the Referees from the warm up balls of the competing teams

## FAIR PLAY FOR ALL TEAMS!

**No Zone defence must be played in under 10, under 12 and under 14 competitions, however, in the interests of fair play (across all grades) and so all teams can enjoy the tournament, if a team is twenty (20) points in front, they are encouraged to not play full or half-court defence, and they are also encouraged to rest their starters and play their bench players, if able to.**

## GENERAL

Bad language and unsporting conduct will not be tolerated during the Carnival and offending players, and/or officials, will be dealt with under the Basketball SA & SA Country Basketball Codes of Conduct. These will apply to all players, coaches, spectators and officials.

Any protest or dispute must be referred in writing to the Tournament Secretary or their substitute within one (1) hour of the completion of the match in question. All protests will be heard by the Carnival Committee.

Special or unusual situations arising during the Carnival will be considered by the Carnival Committee in an effort to reach an amicable solution.

The Referee in Charge, and/or Referees Coaches will be the Rule Interpreters, who will be available to clarify any queries regarding FIBA Rules and their interpretation, as well as the Tournament playing rules.
