## **2021 Competition Rules**

- 1. Fishing to take place between Flags - approx 7km from the Nyah Boat Ramp.**
- 2. Fishing times** - Saturday morning session lines down 7.00am - lines up 12.00 noon. Lunch at Boat Ramp 12.00 noon to 1.00pm – all food provided. Saturday afternoon session lines down at 1.00pm – lines up at 6.00pm. Sunday morning session lines down 7.00am lines up 11.00 a.m.  
No fish will be measured during the lunch break on Saturday or after the close of fishing each day.
- 3.** Boats will be permitted to leave 1/2 hour before lines down both mornings but are not to start fishing before designated times.
- 4.** NSW fishing regulations apply at all times and all competitors are to hold a current fishing licence. Limit 2 rods per person, 2 hooks on attended rod and one on second rod, Juniors limited to 1 rod each. Lures accepted.
- 5. Two persons per boat except where Juniors are entered, three persons per boat with one adult.** Boats that have junior entrants are made up of two under sixteen and one adult or two adults and one under sixteen. All Boats are limited to four rods. Only two catch point prizes will be issued per winning Boat.
- 6.** No fishing is to be done by contestants or any other person from any boat used for accommodation purposes. Boats used for accommodation will be checked at the start of fishing each day.
- 7.** A points system applies with 1 point awarded per 1cm of fish. Fish will be measured to the nearest 0.5cm and 1/2 points will be awarded. Total catch points receive a prize for each person.  
e.g. 60 cm Cod = 60 points, 35cm Yellow Belly = 35 points.
- 8.** Only fish named and of size stated will be measured to claim points. COD must be legal size or bigger. All natives are CATCH & RELEASE ONLY. YELLOWBELLY must be 30cm or bigger. Points will not be awarded to any native fish that is not returned to the water alive.
- 9. "CATCH, CLICK AND RELEASE" RULES:**  
Fish to be photographed immediately after capture in a manner by which judges can determine total length of fish. Fish must be measured on the official "Brag Mat" in the manner indicated on the mat. Place individual ID card so it is visible in the photo. Native Fish must be returned to the water immediately after photo is taken. Photos must be received to be counted in session or entire competition and will be acknowledged when received.
- 10. NO FISH ARE TO BE KEPT IN LIVE WELLS.**
- 11.** The boat with the highest combined points at the end of the competition will be named the winner. If two or more boats finish on the same amount of points at the end of the competition the boat with the highest scoring fish will be named the winner.
- 12.** Saturday morning, Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning session winners.  
\* Highest Points winner in the session will receive a prize.  
\* If equal points occur with 2 or more boats a draw for winner will take place.
- 13.** When a native fish is caught gently remove the hook or cut the line if the hook is deep.
- 14 .** Any contestant caught not following the rules will be disqualified with no refund of money.
- 15.** COMPETITION OFFICIALS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO WARN OR DISQUALIFY ANY COMPETITOR DEEMED TO BE CREATING A NUISANCE EITHER AT THE COMP SITE OR ON THE WATER. Any competitor with a grievance should direct it to an official.
- 16.** Competitors will be issued with arm bands at registration. These must be presented for meals. Juniors and extra meal arm bands will be issued in another colour. Meals will be served between set times it is up to you to collect your meal between these times.
- 17. A quiet area will be set aside at the reserve - ask officials for directions.**
- 18.** Early Bird Draw will take place on Friday night. You do NOT HAVE TO BE PRESENT to win.
- 19. The major cash draw** will take place on Saturday night. You must be present to claim prizes. Non attendance will result in a redraw.

## Entry Fee and Entitlements:

The cost per person is \$140 (under 16's \$70) which includes a ticket in the major draw.

You do not have to catch a fish to win a prize, but winners must be in attendance to accept prizes (Non attendance will result in a redraw).

All main meals provided at no cost.

Competitors are to order any extra meals for spouses or friends not entered in the competition at \$10 per meal or under 16 's \$5.00 meal.
