PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct applies to all of our Players.



- **Play by the rules**, the rules of the game and the rules set down by the Bendigo Junior Football League, the Marong Football Netball Club and the team coach.
- **Never argue with an umpire or other official** – without these people you can't play football .
- **Control your temper**. Verbal or physical abuse of officials or other players, or provoking an opponent is not acceptable and doesn't help you enjoy or win any games
- **Work equally hard for yourself and for your team**. Your team's performance will benefit, so will you.
- **Be a good sport**. Applaud all good plays whether they be by your team, opponent or the other team. Be proud to walk off the ground after each game knowing that you have given your best effort and never involve yourself in an argument with opposing players, umpires or officials.
- **Treat all players as you would like to be treated**. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player. Always conduct yourself in a manner that is expected of your team mates, Club and family.
- **Cooperate with your coach, the umpires, team mates and opponents**. Without them there would no game.
- **Play for your own enjoyment & to improve your skills** .
- **Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability** – you'll let down your coach, team-mates and family if you do & *many such comments are actually now illegal*.
- **Be prepared to take responsibility for your actions**.

PARENTS, SUPPORTERS & OFFICIALS CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct applies to all of our Parents, Officials and Spectators of Registered Junior Players.

- Remember that you are there for the participants to enjoy the game.
- Encourage participation, but don't force it.
- Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning .
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses – supporters are there to support not downgrade.
- Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires and spectators – physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Recognise all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time.
- Never publicly criticise umpires – raise personal concerns with club officials in private.
- Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – you'll let down your family and yourself if you do – & many such comments are actually now illegal.
