GENERAL NOTES

- 1. Umpires have the right to send any offence to the Tribunal and will note this on the report sheet.
- 2. Serious offences such as eye gouging, head butting, elbowing must be referred to the Tribunal.
- 3. Two reports on same day,
 - 1st report: Prescribed Penalty if available;
 - 2nd report: Tribunal.
- 4. Second reportable offence within 2 years
 - (a) Different offence: Prescribed Penalty
 - (b) Same offence: Prescribed Penalty plus 1 match.
- 5. Third reportable offence within 3 years: Must go to the Tribunal

Intentionally, or carelessly kicking another person

Attempting to kick another Person

Intentionally, or carelessly striking another Person

Degree of Intent – Clarification

Where any of the Reportable Offences listed in Law 21.2.2 specify that conduct may be intentional or careless:

- (a) any report or notice of report which does not allege whether the conduct was intentional or careless shall be deemed to and be read as alleging that the conduct was either intentional or careless; and
- (b) the Tribunal or other body appointed to hear and determine the report may find the report proven if it is satisfied on the balance of probabilities that the conduct was either intentional or careless.

Such requests shall be in writing and delivered to the Secretary BLGFA by no later than 6pm on the day following the match.
