## BVABA – 2021 QUEEN'S BIRTHDAY SENIOR CLASSIC - TOURNAMENT RULES

Team officials are advised to read thoroughly the following RULES and make certain that their coaches/players are thoroughly conversant with the Rules. Additional copies of the rules can be obtained on request.

- 1. No player is allowed to play in more than one team or Grade.
- 2. A player must play in two games to be eligible for finals. (There will be at the least 4 games per team).
- A player not seated on the bench must have their name deleted from the score sheet at half time. Should such a player arrive at half time their name will be reinstated on the score sheet by the umpire
- 4. No nomination of teams for the Carnival will be accepted without the appropriate entry fee being paid.
- 5. Each team <u>must provide a competent scorer or time keeper</u> for each entire game in which that team plays. The penalty for not doing so shall be 5 points awarded to the opposing team.
  - All A Grade teams listed as the home team must provide 2 scorers (1 for 24 second clock)
- 6. All teams and player must register on line by the nomination close date.
- 7. Any team not present on the court at the scheduled starting time shall be penalised two points for each minute, or part thereof, that the team is late. Any team more than ten minutes late shall forfeit the match concerned.
- 8. Forfeits shall count as a 20 0 loss to the team forfeiting and a 20 0 win to the opposing team.
- 9. Premiership points shall be 2 win, 1 draw, 0 loss -1 forfeit -2 disqualified.
- 10. In the case of a tie for final position, total percentage will decide.
- 11. Bad language and unsporting conduct will not be tolerated during the Carnival and offending players, and/or officials, will be dealt with severely by the Tribunal. BVABA Codes of Conduct will apply to all players, coaches, spectators and officials.
- 12. Every player must wear the uniform nominated by their club (each violation awards 2 points to the opposition). If possible, also bring "alternate" uniforms.
- 13. No player will be permitted to enter the court if incorrectly dressed.
- 14. All teams provide their own warm up balls. The match ball will be chosen from the warm up balls
- 15. EACH TEAM MUST BE AVAILABLE ALL 3 DAYS OF THE TOURNAMENT AND PLAY ALL GAMES AS PROGRAMMED.
- 16. Any protest or dispute must be referred in writing to the Carnival Manager or their substitute within one (1) hour of the completion of the match in question. Each protest must be accompanied by a \$100.00 protest fee. All protests will be heard by the Carnival Committee.
- 17. Special or unusual situations arising during the Carnival will be considered by the Carnival Committee in an effort to reach an amicable solution.
- 18. The Referee in Charge will be the Rule Interpreter, who will handle any problems or complaints regarding F.I.B.A. and Carnival Rules.
- 19. Any breach of these rules will be dealt with by the Carnival Committee.
- 20. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to re-grade teams depending on the standard and number of entries.
- 21. Clubs/Teams will be held responsible for any damage at the playing venue(s).
- 22. Any team with an NBL1 player must nominate for A Grade. Only 2 NBL1 or Reserves players allowed per team in the interests of "even" competition.

### 23. TIMING

- 23.1. TIMING A GRADE, all games fully timed 8 minute quarters with shot clock
- 23.2. All other grades  $-4 \times 10$  minute quarters with running clock, no timeouts in last 2 minutes of first 3 quarters and clock stops for all whistles in the final 2 minutes of the  $4^{th}$  quarter.
- 23.3. FINALS:- The same as "Minor Round". .Extra time if needed will be 3 minutes per extra period until a result is achieved (for each OT period 1 time out per team, clock stops in the final minute on every whistle, team foul count continues from 4<sup>th</sup> quarter)
- 24. FIRST AID: Each team will need to provide their own first aid requirements.
- 25. INSURANCE: All players play at öwn risk" and are responsible for their own medical and ambulance requirements.
- 26. VIDEOS: Filming of games is not permitted in any capacity without the express permission from the Carnival Committee.
- 27. MINORS (Persons under 18): Any team with a player, scorer, coach or team managers that are under the age of 18 MUST have a minimum of 1 person that holds a current DCSI Working with children clearance, preferably 2. The person with the DCSI clearance must be with the team at all times that the minor is involved.
