



The Ode

"They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old; Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn. At the going down of the sun and in the morning We will remember them."

The Ode is taken from the elegy *For The Fallen*, by English poet and writer Laurence Binyon and was published in London in *The Winnowing Fan; Poems of the Great War* in 1914. The fourth verse, which became the League Ode, was already used in association with commemoration services in Australia in 1921 and not only adorns War Memorials throughout the British Commonwealth but is at the heart of all rites of the RSL.

ORIGINS OF OUR NATIONAL ANTHEM

The original composition of the song 'Advance Australia Fair', written by Peter Dodds McCormick in 1878, had four verses.

Between 1973 and 1984, a competition and several national polls were held to determine the Australian public's opinion of their desired national anthem.

Several of the polls indicated that 'Advance Australia Fair' was favoured, followed by 'Waltzing Matilda'.

In 1981, the National Australia Day Council recommended the Australian National Anthem consist of the first and second verses of 'Advance Australia Fair', with some modifications.

In April 1984, then Governor-General, the Rt Hon Sir Ninian M Stephen KG AK GCMG GCVO KBE QC, proclaimed 'Advance Australia Fair' as the Australian National Anthem, using the verses drafted by the National Australia Day Council.

On 1 January 2021, the words of the second line of the Australian National Anthem were amended from 'For we are young and free' to 'For we are one and free', by proclamation made by the Governor-General, His Excellency General the Honourable David Hurley AC DSC (Retd), on the Australian Government's advice.
