Judo Competition Manual Belau Games 2021

1. LOGISTICS

- 1.1. The Palau Judo Federation shall be responsible for organizing the judo competition for the 2021 Belau Games. The competition shall be governed according to the rules and regulations of the Palau Judo Federation supported by the International Judo Federation (IJF).
- 1.2. The technical meeting will be held at the Palau Judo Federation temporary dojo (Former Bangikoi Store) at a later date with all State Representatives to discuss all rules, regulations, and other important information related to the judo competition.
- 1.3. The competition shall be held on 17th, June 2021, beginning at 4 pm at the PJF Dojo.
- 1.4. The registration, practice will be held on June 15 and 16, 2021 at 5:30 pm. On June 17, 2021 weigh-in shall be held starting 4:30 pm, at the PJF Dojo. The draw shall follow immediately after the weigh-in.

2. CATEGORIES

The competition shall consist of the following categories:

- 1. Youth boys and girls under 8 and under (Boys and Girls mixed)
 - 1. Under 25kg
- 2. Youth boys and girls 8 and under (Boys and Girls mixed)
 - 1. -25kg
 - 2. -30kg
 - 3. -35kg
 - 4. -40kg
- 3. Juniors boys and girls 8-11 (Boys and Girls mixed)
 - 1. -30kg
 - 2. -35kg
 - 3. -40kg
 - 4. +40kg
- 4. Senior boys and girls 11-15 (Boys and Girls mixed)
 - 1. -40kg
 - 2. -45kg
 - 3. -50kg
 - 4. +50kg
- 5. Cadet men and women 15-18 (Boys and Girls Separately)
 - 1. -65kg

- 2. -70kg
- 3. +70 kg
- 6. Senior men and women 18 and over (Boys and Girls Separately)
 - 1. -65kg
 - 2. -70kg
 - 3. -80kg
 - 4. -90kg
 - 5. -100kg
 - 6. +100kg
- 7. Boys and Girls Open Category
- 2.2 If there is only two entry in a weight division, the players will be entered and compete in the closest weight class.
- 2.3 Competitors from the same state should be drawn into separate halves of the draw.
- 3. COMPETITION
- 3.1 Contest Times
 - 1. Youth 2 minutes
 - 2. Junior boys & girls 3 minutes
 - 3. Senior boys & girls 3 minutes
 - 4. Cadets 4 minutes
 - 5. Seniors/Open 5 minutes
- 3.2 There shall be one referee on the tatami, one score/time keeper at the officials table, and two volunteers at the draw table.
- 3.3 Scoring

The following scores shall be awarded:

Waza-ari 10 points Ippon 100 points

Osaekomi:

Waza-ari 15 seconds Ippon 20 seconds

4. MEDALS

There shall be a Gold, Silver, and Bronze medal for each category in each division (a total of 21 medals shall be available for awarding).

^{*}Kansetsu Waza (armlocks) and Shime Waza (strangles) are not allowed for the youth and Junior categories.
