Welcome to the 2021 Basketball Wagga Wagga Spring Competition. This information pack is to try and give you as much information about our competition season as possible.

General Information

- Competition commences from 1st August 2021
- 12 weeks of regular season games, in addition to 2 weeks of 'Finals'
- Team nominations open Monday 12th July 2021
- Team nominations close Friday 23rd July 2021

- Men's U23 Sunday night commences 1st August 2021
- Z League Monday night commences 30th August 2021
- Men's Division 2 Wednesday night commences Wednesday 4th August 2021
- Men's Division 3 Wednesday night commences Wednesday 4th August 2021
- Women's Division 1 Monday night commences Monday 2nd August 2021
- Women's Division 2 Sunday night to commence Sunday 1st August 2021

Player Registration

ALL individuals intending to play in the Senior Spring Competition must be registered with Wagga Basketball. No player will be allowed to take the court under any circumstance prior to being registered. Registration is to be completed online and will be received by the Association Administrator. Players can check if registration is current or expired by typing member.basketball.net.au into their browser and logging in with their SportsTG email/password. Once logged in, they'll be able to:

- Update email address
- Upload a photo
- Update address
- Check membership history
- Check transaction history
- See playing statistics

ALL PLAYERS MUST UPLOAD A PHOTO TO THEIR SPORTSTG DATABASE BEFORE THE START OF THE SPRING COMPETITIONS. PHOTO MUST BE OF OWN FACE AND NOT OF ANYTHING ELSE.

<u>New members</u> – if you are registering for the first time once you have completed a membership form, agreed to the terms and conditions and paid the relevant fees your membership is valid for 12 months from the date of registration.

<u>An existing member renewing within 30 days</u>. If you renew your membership within 30-days of it expiring, your new expiry date is 12 months from the previous expiry date.

<u>An existing member who renews after 30 days</u>. If you renew your registration after 30-days of it expiring, your new expiry date is 12-months from the date you have completed a registration form, agreed to the terms and conditions and paid the relevant membership fees.

In 2021 competition fees are going to be individual like our juniors. **The price will be \$160.00** per individual and **7** players will be required to enter a team.

Teams who nominated online previously can use their existing team code and password to nominate in 2021 Spring Competition. All new teams please use New Team Registration.

For new teams - once you nominate a team, you will receive a team code and password, with which you will be able to invite all team members to join your team using their email addresses. For existing teams who are re-entering – once you nominate please also invite your team members to join your team using their email addresses. **All team members must join teams via the online process prior to start of the competition.** Please contact the Association Administrator should you face any difficulties in nominating your team.

Player Joining Team Registration

From the website click onto Player Joining SENIOR TEAM Registration Form

All players must join their team & pay competition fees (and be currently registered) via the online process before they can take the court for round 1. A team list of players who have joined will be forwarded to the team contact before the commencement of competition. The team contact must ensure all players have joined their team prior to commencement of competition and follow up any players who have not joined. If players have not successfully joined their team prior to round 1 they may not be allowed to take the court until the online process has been completed.

Team Support BENCH SCORER

All teams will require a bench scorer, if a scorer is not allocated at the start of the game the team may be penalised.

Electronic Scoring

Courtside scoring will be used from Round 1 of competitions. This is iPad based and replaces the scoresheet. Again, it is imperative that each team supply at least one person to do scoring duties for their game.

Player & Coach Behaviour – (please see additional information below)

In an effort to control inappropriate player behaviour we have implemented the following penalties for an accumulation of Technical Fouls during the season. Please read the below Code of Behaviour for players and coaches.

2 per year – Written Warning

- 4 per year 2 playing week suspension
- 6 per year 4 playing week suspension
- 8 per year 8 playing week suspension
- 10 per year Rest of Season suspension, plus next season suspension.

These penalties are separate to any penalties handed down by the Disciplinary Tribunal.

WWBA will be continuing with the following for all games;

• A player who receives a technical foul will be substituted out of the game for five (5) minutes and cannot be replaced by another player for the duration.
