Basketball Queensland Transfer Policy

The transfer policy will remain the same as per previous seasons (as noted in the Transfer Policy on the BQ website). Transfers will continue to be done online via the Sports TG platform until further notice.

As the first day of grading for U18/U21s is scheduled for 4th of September, all transfers will need to be approved by 5th August (30 days). In order to give associations the maximum 7 days of refusing a transfer due to money owing, all transfers for U18/U21 need to be submitted by 29th July to ensure that the full 30 days plus the additional 7 days for right of refusal is catered for.

BQ will automatically approve a transfer once the 7 days has elapsed from when the transfer has been submitted. The original association can have up to 7 days to approve the transfer or deny it due to outstanding fees owing. If the association does not approve after 7 days, BQ will process it immediately.

Permission to trial forms are still required to be kept on file by associations. Associations do not need to send copies to BQ; however, they must be available on request.

Basketball Queensland Transfer Dates & Deadlines 2021-22

To ensure that the mandatory 30-day waiting period is served, the below dates are listed as a guide to submit and approve transfers prior to the 2021-22 SQJBC season.

Under 18 & Under 21

All Transfers for U18/U21 are to be submitted prior to **29 July 2021**.
All Transfers for U18/U21 are to be approved by **5 August 2021**.
First day of U18/U21 Grading is scheduled for **4 September 2021**.

Under 16

All Transfers for U16 are to be submitted prior to **21 October 2021**.
All Transfers for U16 are to be approved by **28 October 2021**.
First day of U16 Grading is scheduled for **27 November 2021**.

Under 14

All Transfers for U14 are to be submitted prior to **10 February 2022**.
All Transfers for U14 are to be approved by **17 February 2022**.
First day of U14 Grading is scheduled for **19 March 2022**.

Under 12

All Transfers for U12 are to be submitted prior to **5 May 2022**.
All Transfers for U12 are to be approved by **12 May 2022**.
First day of U12 Grading is scheduled for **11 June 2022**.

Competition Fees

SQJBC Nomination Fees

Nomination fees are \$250 per team (inclusive of GST). Basketball Queensland will invoice associations once all nominations have been confirmed.

Grading Fees

The cost of participation, number of venues required and formatting of games to be established when nominations close and the number of teams is known.

Game Fees

Game fees of \$95 per team per game is payable to each host association for the following games:

- All regular season games
- Wildcard Challenge
- Semi Finals

Game fees cover the court hire, referees, first aid and court controller/staff payments for all associations hosting games.

Basketball Queensland will collect all game fees prior to each age group's season and redistribute these amounts to each association based on the number of games they host at their venue.

SQJBC Schedule Format

The SQJBC season for each age group is split into four sections:

1. Grading
2. Regular Season (14 rounds)
3. Wildcard Challenge
4. Finals Weekend

1. Grading

- SQJBC Grading Competitions will be held in the previous term to which the regular season is held. For example, the U18 Grading tournament will be held in Term 3, with the Regular Season to be held in Term 4.
- The cost of participation, number of venues required and formatting of games to be established when nominations close and the number of teams is known.

2. Regular Season

The SQJBC Regular Season is split into 5 weekends for a total of 14 rounds.

- Carnival 1 – 4 games held over two days – Saturday & Sunday.
- Carnival 2 – 2 games held on one day – either a Saturday or Sunday.
- Carnival 3 – 2 games held on one day – either a Saturday or Sunday.
- Carnival 4 – 2 games held on one day – either a Saturday or Sunday.
- Carnival 5 – 4 games held over two days – Saturday & Sunday.

To maximise venue availability, a division's double-header (Carnivals 2, 3 & 4) may be held on a Saturday or Sunday. Not all divisions will play on the same day. For example, U18 Boys Premier League may have games scheduled on a Saturday, whilst the U18 Girls Southern Cup may have games scheduled on a Sunday of the same weekend.

3. Wildcard Challenge

The Wildcard Challenge for all age groups (excluding the U21 age group) will be played the weekend after the final carnival round.

Teams are automatically seeded to their relevant divisions for the State Championships (i.e., Premier League – Division 1, Southern Cup – Division 2). However, the Wildcard Challenge provides teams who finished 1st and 2nd in a lower division an opportunity to challenge teams who finished 7th and 8th in a higher division for their spot in the State Championships.

Teams from a higher division may relinquish their position to a team from a lower division if the team from the lower division wishes to challenge.

4. Finals Weekend

The Finals Weekend will take place one week after the Wildcard Challenge. Semi Finals will be played on Saturday followed by the Grand Finals on Sunday.
