Donations Policy

The aim of this policy is to provide an outline of what financial assistance will be provided and the steps involved in having donations approved.

This policy only applies to financial and playing members of Tumut Basketball and must be registered with Basketball NSW.

1. Southern Junior League Teams
2. Junior members selected for Riverina or State
3. Junior members representing Schools at a State level
4. Junior members chosen for Sports Academy or other NSW Basketball approved programs

[Tumut Basketball will allocate a maximum of \\$1500 per financial year for the purpose outlined in this policy.](#)

Details	Financial Amount	Availability
Sports Academy / BBNSWprogram	<u>Up to a maximum of \$150.00</u>	Once per calendar year (1 Jan to <u>31 October</u>) per member
School Representative – State	<u>Up to a maximum of \$100.00</u>	<u>Once per calendar year (1 Jan to 31 October) per member</u>
Southern Junior League Teams (where not Rep team)	Half of round fees	<u>Assessed on application</u>

Total donation per player per **calendar** year must not exceed \$500.00

Requests for individual players must be received in writing [Applications must be on the approved application form available on our association website at \[www.tumut.basketball.net.au\]\(http://www.tumut.basketball.net.au\)](#)

Southern Junior League teams will be assessed by the Directors once teams have been formed. Round fees will be paid by the Association with the association to receive reimbursement due 1-week prior to start of round. Where the teams make state finals financial assistance per the above table will be paid to players involved.

Rep carnivals. Carnival fees will be paid by the Association from the Rep account. If funds are not available round fees will be paid by players.

This policy will be due to be reviewed yearly at the Annual General Meeting.

Applications will be received from January to October with money granted at November Meeting.

REPRESENTATIVE CARNIVAL – FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM ASSOCIATION.

Representative Financial Assistance

Carnival fees will be paid by the Association with contribution from players required prior to attending the carnival.

Players will be invoiced for a fee set each year currently \$60. This fee covers \$50.00 towards the nomination fee and \$10 towards the cost of the coach attending.

REIMBURSEMENT OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS & REFEREES ATTENDING COURSES / MEETINGS.

Basketball will reimburse committee members and referees attending approved BBNSW or attending BBNSW related meetings.

Reimbursement will be approved on receipt of a course receipt and/or documentation confirming attendance at a course with accompanying reimbursement request form.

Reimbursement of petrol for committee members required to attending meetings held by BBNSW on proof of receipt with accompanying reimbursement request form.
