- Accept all decisions made by referees. Understand and teach children that referees sometimesmake mistakes too; they are umpiring to the best of their ability.
- ❖ Work on controlling your frustration; recompose, try taking a deep breath and think about what the bestresponse for the team is and all the members of the club.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Show appreciation and respect for all volunteers; this includes coaches, officials and administrators.
