## 2020-21 Club Mission

# Encouraging participation

Due to the hard work of our Committee to be Return to Play ready, TSC was one of the first junior clubs to be back on the court to begin preseason training when the 2020 lockdown ended. TSC hit the courts on 15 June 2020, a month before the 2020 Winter competition began in July.

For the 2021 Winter junior season, we took a more proactive approach and reached out to local schools prior to registration. We saw an overall increase of nine teams to 46 junior teams (compared to 37 in 2020, 41 in 2019, 36 in 2018 and 37 in 2017).

We were also one of the first clubs to return to training following the summer break by offering pre-season squad training. Although the 2021 Winter Season didn't begin to mid-March, our pre-season training began the first week of term 1 (from 2 February 2021).

# Treasurer's Report

I am pleased to report that the Club is still in a healthy financial position.

Although we operated at a loss (\$42K) this year, this was simply correcting last year's artificial profit (\$52K) caused by the winter 2020 season being delayed because of COVID. At the end of the financial year, we had \$101K in our account which was sufficient equity to cover our season expenses and enough in reserve to pre-pay summer registration fees to take advantage of the BACT early bird discount.

Our financial records have been audited and found to be a fair representation of the income, expenditure and cash assets of the Club. The Balance Sheet, Profit and Loss statement and audit report are provided separately.

I recommend these financial statements to the members and Committee for approval.
