Getting Started

Our club web site contains all the information you will need to make a start, here are the first steps:

- 1. Register and pay our online club membership fee by using the membership link on our web site Search our domain name at southgeelongkings.com.au to find us.
- 2. Go to our membership link and follow instructions for online membership where you can also order a playing singlet if you require one.
- 3. To complete your uniform, purchase yourself a pair of plain black basketball shorts at a sporting retailer or store that sells sporting apparel.
- 4. The membership link from our website also goes to the Geelong United Association website where you can pay your Association fees.

Training

Kings club/team training is available at the indoor basketball gym at the Montpellier Primary School, Mt Pleasant Road in Highton mostly on Sundays. Our training schedule sessions will be listed on the web site for regular club training, not usually during school holidays.

Teams

Your team will be coordinated and managed by a nominated team manager, usually a parent of one of the players, this can be a shared duty and usually consists of communicating with the team and helping out on game days/nights, also supporting the coach by organising a scorer every game among the parents.

Team lists, with the name and contact details of coaches and team contacts/managers will be posted and updated on our web site from time to time as new seasons approach. The committee updates these lists; please notify us if you are missing from one of our team lists so we can make the necessary amendments.

Scoring

Scoring is a club requirement and shared duty among all parents as per our by-laws.

Manager

The team manager should have your email and mobile number contact details and if you are not sure about who your team manager is remember to contact the club and ask us, we will connect you. Also you can check the team lists online for details of each team's coach and manager.

Coach

The team coach may be appointed by the club or nominated from among the parent group. As parents make great coaches we will support/mentor any parents who wish to coach, but may not feel confident at the start, to help you along the way and also provide opportunity to improve coaching skills should you wish to attend courses. There is a level 1 basketball coaching manual to download on our website.

Culture

The Kings basketball club is a community focused sporting club welcoming anyone who wishes to play basketball, all we ask is that those who join us be prepared to step up and be part of the club, its community ethos, culture and statement of purpose.
