Policy Objectives

To provide a clear statement of the expectations in relation to COVID vaccinations for:

- WDNA Officials
 - Umpires
 - Representative team coaches
 - Association officials and committee
 - Other people in paid roles that are active in the WDNA Community
 - Suppliers of services to WDNA and, on WDNA premises (WDNA Service Providers)
- The broader WDNA netball community (including players, team & Club officials, and spectators)

Policy Rationale

Vaccination is the most effective way to protect against infectious diseases. Vaccines strengthen your immune system by training it to recognise and fight against specific viruses. When you get vaccinated, you are protecting yourself and helping to protect the whole community. When enough people in the community are vaccinated, it slows down the spread of disease. (Australian Government – Department of Health)

COVID Vaccination Requirements for WDNA Officials, Service Providers, and community

In line with the Victorian Government Roadmap, these requirements relate to anyone attending WDNA run competition or events at the Ashwood courts or Oakleigh Recreation Centre or anyone representing WDNA at external venues. This policy will be updated if we receive further advice in relation to vaccine status requirements.

40 years and over requirements

- Fully vaccinated prior to attending

16 to 39 years old requirements:

- Must have received at a minimum their first vaccination prior to attending
- Second vaccination must be received on or before 5 November 2021 (as per the Victorian Government Roadmap).

12 to 15 years old

- As per government guidelines (when released)

For anyone who has not met our requirements, please contact us to discuss. If this is due to a medical exemption, a copy of the exemption must be sighted to us. We understand that there has been some delay with the vaccine rollout and that for medical reasons, some of our community may not be able to be vaccinated.

WDNA will follow the direction provided by the Victorian State Government, DHHS, Netball Victoria and Monash Council and expect our community to abide by these directions.
