# FINANCE REPORT

The clubs financial statements have been audited and PMBA is compliant in all respects as per the auditors report.

#### **Financial Position**

Your community club is in a strong financial position with a healthy balance sheet. Cash reserves have been built up over successive years of small surpluses by previous treasurers, committees and boards. When Covid hit, PMBA was prepared to withstand all challenges financially now and also in the future.

### **Covid Impact**

PMBA has seen significant disruption and increased costs from Covid compliance. We incur these costs in providing a safe environment in which to conduct community basketball.

All clubs operating community sport during a pandemic have faced significant extra costs and budgetary challenges. For PMBA this has been made easier due to the club's financial stability and allowed PMBA to position ourselves for continued growth rather than having to rebuild.

As we look ahead to a vaccinated population, better operating conditions for all aspects of the club will hopefully resume.

#### Investment

PMBA has invested some of our significant surplus funds into retention and continued refereeing development and new junior pathway development.

PMBA engaged the services of Robert Linton from North Coast Basketball, to undertake PMBA's development work. PMBA has taken advantage of the Active Schools program to partially fund this development work, which is a great government initiative and a natural fit to recruit more members.

Whilst a funded Development Officer role is significant expenditure it is critical to bolster the youngest age groups that are the foundation of the clubs player growth, officials growth and representative future.

The Association will continue to invest in coaches, scoretable and referee development to provide better opportunities and outcomes for all our members.
