

WBA Junior Basketball Competition Summary Sheet



- The QR code will take you to the full bylaws
- The Age Group Table (below) can be found on the Willetton website.
- Games are an automatic forfeit if players play outside the age table guidelines without Competitions Advisory Committee (CAC) approval.
- A player can play no more than 4 games in grades higher than his/her nominated grade.
- A player cannot play in a lower grade than that in which they are registered.
- A player cannot play in a different domestic club than the domestic club in which they are registered.
- A player cannot play in a different team to their registered team, in the same grade in which they are registered.
- Mercy rule: Scorers must alert the referees when a team leads by the mentioned points listed
 - 8s and 10s – 10 points
 - 12s – 20 points
 - 14s, 16s and 18s – 30 points
- Successful 3 point shots count as 3 points for all 12s and over competitions
- Successful 3 point shots count as **2** points for all 8s and 10s competitions
- Scoreboards shall be used for all grades in **10s and over**
