Additional fees:

In addition to team entry fees, each player is required to pay:

- \$25 Harbour Basketball Membership fee
- \$6.50 Glory League Fee

Referees: Harbour Basketball will attempt to supply two referees per game where possible.

Uniforms: Please refer to Rule 11 of the North Harbour Secondary Schools Competition Rules and Regulations.

Score bench duties: Each team will be required to supply 2 persons per game for score bench. Score Bench roles include:

- Glory League – used as the official record of the game and enables video capture of games. This replaces scoresheets.
- Scoreboard – This roll should require 2 people. One to keep a record of the score and team fouls that are visible on the score board. A second person to control the game clock and timeouts.
- Shot clock - This will be used at all venues except the YMCA.

A score bench course will be offered prior to the start of the season.

Payment: Schools will be invoiced based on team entries and total number of players/members. This payment must be made via internet banking.

Registrations: Each school will be required to have a dedicated school contact to administer the club (School) on the GameDay database. Each player, coach and manager will be required to register using an online registration form. Club (School) administrators will be required to place players into their respective teams through an admin portal in the GameDay database. **Team names, the grade they are entering and total number of players/members in the school is all that is required to enter initially.**
