The GVFUA Executive are excited to announce Andrew Moore as our new Regional Director of Umpiring (RDU).

Andrew is well known to the majority of GVFUA members, having umpired with the GVFUA since 2006, A past president of the GVFUA, Andrew has a wealth of knowledge within the GVFUA and the broader umpiring community.

Along with a wealth of umpiring experience, Andrew brings to the association fantastic administration skills, which he has picked up through his previous roles.

The GVFUA would like to thank previous RDU Sam Wood for his amazing work over his time in the role with AFL Goulburn Murray. We wish Sam all the best with his future endeavours in the VFL umpiring department.

The RDU role will include administration responsibilities for the GVFUA as well as promoting and developing umpiring across the Goulburn Valley Region. This will include, but not limited to, managing the recruitment, NUA program, tribunal co-ordinator and sponsorship. Andrew will be the first point of call for all clubs and leagues who have umpiring questions and concerns.

Umpire retention numbers have taken a hit since last season Covid Interruptions and the GVFUA need your help to make sure that the majority of local football games have appointed umpires in those games. The GVFUA now train Tuesday and Thursdays from 6pm till 7pm at their 3 training bases in Kialla, Kyabram and Seymour. If you are interested in umpiring, whether you've finished playing footy and still want to be involved, or you want a bit of extra pocket money and be paid to keep fit, then umpiring is for you. In 2022 there will again be a Zero Tolerance to Umpire Abuse. Any abuse towards umpires from players or officials, whether it be verbal abuse, disputing an umpire's decision, or demonstrative behaviour towards umpires will result in a free kick, 50m penalty and potentially a report.

To remove any grey area regarding who the abuse may have been directed at. Umpires will be directed to penalise any player who is using abusive or foul language. This will include swearing.

The GVFUA understands that many supporters are passionate about their club and love to support them.

They create the atmosphere around the ground that is loved by both players and umpires. However, we believe it is imperative that this behaviour does not become abusive to either umpires or opposition players.

We ask if a supporter is getting a bit too passionate that a club official remind them to support but not abuse.




