#Country Championships a player turning 18 in 2023 are not eligible to play in an U18 CBA representative team. Junior playing Senior A or B women or Men please register as a Senior or contact CBA if you are not sure.

All junior players are allocated into teams by CBA committee. Depending on registration numbers players may have the opportunity to play up a grade if required. All members are to play in their true grade regardless of ability. There are guidelines in regards to fill in players if teams are short. Please see a committee member before the scheduled game, ALL players must be added to the team list before the commencement of the game. If a player is not added to the team in time, then this player is the T1 or T2 player on the score sheet, and this player must be added to the vote card as a fill in; (Name and team to be recorded for finals qualification)

Playing tops can also be collected at this time by the team coach or representative as a team and will be the responsibility to hand to players, tops can be exchanged due to size as needed.

See the Uniform Co-Ordinator and more communication will be shared in regards to players top collection soon.

Playing tops are the property of CBA and must be returned to the TEAM COACH OR MANAGER on the last playing date of your team. Once signed off the bag is returned as a team to the Uniform Co Ordinator.

Failure to return the playing top makes the player ineligible for the next season and to return to the competition a \$40 uniform charge is invoiced to the player for a replacement playing top.

CBA- 12 & 14 U GUIDELINES

- ✓ Our philosophy for the competition is based on **PARTICIPATION** and **ENJOYMENT**. While we acknowledge that winning is important, at this level we also need to encourage all players to continue playing and enjoying the game of basketball in the future.
- ✓ **No Zone Rule:** Players **MUST** play man-to-man defence, that is - No Zone Defence. This is a Basketball Australia rule and applies until players reach U/16's. The idea behind this is that children are taught to play **good defence**, which means moving their feet, watching their own player as well as the ball and good positioning for 'help' defence. This rule also applies at Country Championships and they actually have a 'Zone Busting' team to ensure that man to man defence is being played. All players to man up or be moving to unmanned player, avoid the 'tall player' from sitting in the key way. The document can be found on our web page.
- ✓ **Fill in/Playing up:** **CBA will allocate a player from a grade below if deemed necessary.** Fill in players are to be used when required during the game if; a team does not have a sub, there is an injury or used sparingly. These players should not be taking the court time of a regular grade player as this is their allocated grade. By all means the player can be the bench player reserve, join in at training and be a vital part of the team. If the team has 5 grade players, the fill in/playing up team member must not start as a starting five player. A great opportunity to learn and the committee will be looking for players to play up a grade to encourage game development and challenge these players. In regards to a fill in on the day a coach must approach committee before selecting a player.
- ✓ **Good sportsmanship:** Please promote good sportsmanship, by encouraging players to congratulate good play (even by the other team!), to shake hands and give 3 cheers after each game. For those who are unsure, players should form a circle in the middle of the court at the end of the game and give 3 cheers to each other as well as the referees.
- ✓ **Mercy Rule:** If your team is winning by more than 20 points your team, must play defence from behind the half way line (or the 3 point line if you are already behind the half way line). As you will appreciate it is disheartening and demoralising for teams to be beaten by 30 to 50 points. In addition, it does not teach either team very much. If you find your team winning by a large margin, why not change the team rules a little. For example, do not let your team dribble the ball (teaches them to look for a good pass, helps them gain better control); make sure every player receives a pass before they are allowed to shoot the ball or ensure all players score at least once in every game. The score is not added to on the board please continue to record on computer or sheet.
- ✓ **Court 3 Manual Scoring:** as court 3 does not have a computer assigned, we are using paper form of scoring. Check numbers of players, when recording points, the scorer's number will go beside the score under column A or B, at half time underline the score, personal fouls and record each half score. At full time, umpires check and sign, underline score, fill in half time score and total and sign. THE REF should be checking sheet at half time and full time.
- ✓ **Training:** We would encourage all teams to have their own training sessions. You are able to book a court through Roche Park. Payment to be made before training commences.
