
We must also thank all of the clubs that have helped by recruiting umpires, making the day enjoyable or simply being accommodating, it is all truly appreciated.

Notes to the Financial Statements

For the Year Ended 30 September 2022

The financial statements cover Newcastle Central Cost Umpires Association Incorporated as an individual entity. Newcastle Central Cost Umpires Association Incorporated is a not-for-profit entity incorporated in New South Wales under the *Associations Incorporation Act (NSW) 2009* and *Associations Incorporation Regulation (NSW) 2010* ('the Act').

The principal activities of the entity for the year ended 31 May 2021 were to advance the interests, standing and skills of Australian Football Umpires.

The functional and presentation currency of Newcastle Central Cost Umpires Association Incorporated is Australian dollars.

1 Basis of Preparation

The financial report is a special purpose financial report that has been prepared in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Association. The Committee have determined that the Association is not a reporting entity. The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements established by the Committee.

2 Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

(a) Income Tax

The entity is exempt from income tax under Division 50 of the *Income Tax Assessment Act* 1997.

(b) Revenue from Contracts with Customers

Revenue is recognised on a basis that reflects the transfer of promised goods or services to customers at an amount that reflects the consideration the entity expects to receive in exchange for those goods or services.

Generally, the timing of the payment for sale of goods and rendering of services corresponds closely to the timing of satisfaction of the performance obligations, however where there is a difference, it will result in the recognition of a receivable, contract asset or contract liability.

None of the revenue streams of the entity have any significant financing terms as there is less than 12 months between receipt of funds and satisfaction of performance obligations.

Specific revenue streams

The revenue recognition policies for the principal revenue streams of the Company are:

2 Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

(b) Revenue from Contracts with Customers

Grant income

Where grant income arises from an agreement which is enforceable and contains sufficiently specific performance obligations then the revenue is recognised when control of each performance obligations is satisfied.

Each performance obligation is considered to ensure that the revenue recognition reflects the transfer of control and within grant agreements there may be some performance obligations where control transfers at a point in time and others which have continuous transfer of control over the life of the contract.

Once the assets and liabilities have been recognised then income is recognised for any remaining asset value at the time that the asset is received.

Sale of goods

Revenue is recognised on transfer of goods to the customer as this is deemed to be the point in time when risks and rewards are transferred and performance obligations are satisfied with no residual ownership or effective control over the goods.

Donations

Donations and bequests are recognised as revenue when the entity gains control of the asset.

(c) Volunteer Services

No amounts are included in the financial statements for services donated by volunteers.

(d) Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Revenue is recognised exclusive of GST as the Association is not registered for GST. Expenses and assets are recognised inclusive of GST.

Receivables are stated exclusive of GST and payables are stated inclusive of GST.

Cash flows in the statement of cash flows are included on a gross basis.
