JUNIOR PLAY UP GUIDELINES

Our aim at Collie Basketball Assoc. is to encourage as many juniors in the Collie community to play basketball. We aim to have at least 6 qualified age group players in each team in each division. Plays ups are allocated to teams by CBA.

Points CBA committee considers when allocating 'play ups'

- School Year
- Country Championships attendance (year prior)
- Development program attendance
- Interest by player
- Parent support
- Committee discretion
- COACHING GUIDE for 'Play Ups'

* Play ups will be used at the discretion by the coach, at the start of the game with the following guidelines:

- 7 age grade players is considered a full team and a play up will not be required
- 6 age grade players is considered a full team and a play up will not be required.
- 5 age grade players, 1 play up may be used as a substitute to rest players, foul trouble or injury.
- 4 age grade players, 2 play ups can be used as a substitute to rest players, foul trouble or injury.
- If a team is short on a playing night - FILL IN's may be used this is the same points are applied as above. If play 3 games for a team then qualify for that team. FILL IN is a player not already allocated to a team as a "play up". *Must be added to the score sheet.*
