

Yerrinbool-Bargo Soccer Club Registration Terms & Conditions

By registering yourself or a dependent minor to play soccer with Yerrinbool-Bargo Soccer Club (YBSC), you agree to abide by the following:

General

1. YBSC is a friendly family orientated club and as a player or parent/guardian of a player, you agree to uphold the principles of sporting spirit, fair play culture, embracing diversity, transparency, integrity and respect.

Registrations/De-registrations

- 2. All player registration fees are due prior to teams being submitted to Highlands Soccer Association (HSA).
- 3. Any player who has not paid their registration in full before the first round of the season will be 'inactive' and not eligible to play. Any registrations made after the week of the first round are at the discretion of the Registrar.
- 4. The Club reserves the right to cancel any registration for failure to pay fees prior to the first round of the season.
- Payment plans for registration fees can be negotiated with and are at the discretion of the club.
- 6. Payment plans must be maintained until completion to remain eligible to play.
- 7. If players cannot be registered for any reason (lack of numbers to fill a team) a full refund will be issued.
- 8. Any player wishing to transfer or cancel their registration (de-registration) will make a request in writing (email) to the Club. All de-registration requests must be approved by both the Club and the HSA.
- 9. Any Active Kids Voucher used in conjunction with registration will not be refunded to the participant in the event of a de-registration. Should a de-registered player transfer to another registered Active Kids Provider, the voucher amount may be transferred to that club subject to confirmation of registration from the new club.

Code of Conduct

10. You agree to abide by the YBSC Code of Conduct available on the Club website (www.ybsc.com.au).

Media

11. Photos / Videos of players (Juniors and Seniors), volunteers and those associated present at the time may be taken throughout the season at competition games, training and during club events to post on our social media platforms. They are intended to be general in nature without identifying any individual in particular. Please inform the club in writing (email) if you don't want your child photographed.

Volunteers

12. YBSC is a not for profit club run only by volunteers. We rely on your help from time to time when available. Each team will be asked to assist at times with fundraising such as the meat raffles at Bargo Hotel through the season. This Fundraising activity directs all raised funds back into our club and is vital to keep our fees as low as possible. As a member of YBSC you agree to assist from time to time as requested by your Coach or the Club.

Injury and Insurance

- 13. Players, Parents and children acknowledge that soccer (training & games) is a contact sport and they assume all risks associated with participation in this sport, including but not limited to falls, contact with other participants and equipment, the effects of weather, and other reasonable risk conditions associated with the sport.
- 14. Accordingly players, parents and children will not hold the club liable against any claim of any nature arising out of any injury, loss or damage suffered as a result of any player participating in any authorised club soccer training or game.
- 15. Football NSW provides basic insurance cover for players and others participating in football during games and training but it does not replace the need for private health insurance including ambulance cover, which is recommended for all players. The Club will not be liable for any cost not covered by Football NSW's insurance incurred by any player.
- 16. You give your permission for the Club to arrange medical attention for you or your child that may be deemed necessary including ambulance transport and you agree to pay for all costs incurred.
- 17. The Club agrees that it will endeavor to contact you, if possible, prior to seeking medical treatment for your child, but you understand and accept that it may not be possible to do so in all circumstances. The Club agrees to contact you, or, if not contactable, your child's emergency contact details, as soon as it is practicable to do so.
