Game 1 **QUALIFYING FINAL** ladder position 1 v 2

Game 2 **ELIMINATION FINAL** ladder position 3 v 4

Game 1 **PRELIMINARY FINAL** Loser QUALIFYING FINAL vs Winner ELIMINATION FINAL

Finals Round 3

Game 1 **GRANDFINAL** WINNER QUALIFYING FINAL vs WINNER PRELIMINARY FINAL

Junior Games are 20-minutes halves and 3-minute half time

Senior Games are 25-minute halves and a 3-minute half time

Qualifying, Elimination & Preliminary Final games are all a running clock and no time out in the last 3 minutes of the second half.

Only the GRANDFINAL, the last 3 minutes in the second half is a STOPPED CLOCK.

If games are tied during the **Qualifying, Elimination & Preliminary Final** an extra period is played OVER TIME - on running clock, 5 minutes.

- 1 minute break between the extra period & 5 minutes running clock
- Teams continue in the same direction
- Second half team fouls, game personal fouls & time outs are carried over

GRANDFINAL STOPPED CLOCK Last 3 Minutes

- Second Half the Last 3 minutes is fully timed (Stop Clock)
- Time outs are permitted.
- See guide for Stop Clock.

GRANDFINAL DRAW

- Fully timed extra period – OVERTIME – 3 minutes STOPPED CLOCK
- Teams continue in the same direction
- Second half team fouls & game personal fouls
- One time out per team

STOP CLOCK GUIDE FOR SCORER last 3 minutes

SITUATION	STOP CLOCK WHEN	START CLOCK WHEN
FOULS/VIOLATIONS	REFEREE BLOWS THEIR WHISTLE	BALL IS IN POSSESSION ON COURT
OUT OF BOUNDS	REFEREE BLOWS THEIR WHISTLE	BALL IS IN POSSESSION ON COURT
FREE THROWS	REFEREE BLOWS THEIR WHISTLE	ON THE 2ND SHOT IF SCORED: BALL IS IN POSSESSION ON COURT FROM INBOUND PASS IF MISSES: FROM WHEN BALL IS IN POSSESSION FROM THE REBOUND
FROM A SCORE	WHEN THE BALL PASSES THROUGH THE NET	BALL IS IN POSSESSION ON COURT
TIMEOUT	REFEREE BLOWS THEIR WHISTLE	BALL IS IN POSSESSION ON COURT

TEAM BENCHES

- Comprise of a coach and substitutes.
- The higher-ranking team will sit to the left of the score bench facing onto the court.
- Only the coach and substitutes to sit on the team bench.

SCORE BENCHES

- **Qualifying, Elimination & Preliminary Final** each team will provide a scorer.
- Scores must have experience (no first timers).
- Grand final CBA will provide scorers.
- No spectators to approach the score bench.
- Any questions in regards to the game must be directed to a CBA committee whom is not a coach, referee or scorer during that game.

GENERAL REMINDERS

- **Codes of Conduct apply for Spectators, Scorers, Players, Coaches**

- Teams on the court with 20 seconds prior to the start of the game
- NO players to be added manually during the final's series
- Uniform – Club Tops, tucked in, Black shorts (no football shorts or large branding) preferably with no pockets.
- Mouth guards for ALL juniors
- Nails clipped
- Spectators are asked not to approach the scorer's or team bench during the game at any time of the game, including pre, during and post-match.
- Scorers will be provided by Collie Basketball Committee for the Grand Final games on Saturday 1st April
