

Round 2 Preview - Football

Round two of the Parklea EDFNL home and away season will resume this Saturday after the break for Easter. Last year's runners up Buln Buln will take centre stage again when it plays host to the 2022 preliminary finalist Ellinbank. The second round often makes nonsense of punters and tipsters with dramatic form reversals not uncommon which will keep all interested in what is happening around the grounds.

BULN BULN v ELLINBANK

The Lyrebirds gave notice it was primed for another successful season after it produced a gritty four point victory over Neerim South in the opening round grand final replay. Fleet footed recruit Riley Rundell and Mitch Nobelius who has returned to the club both impressed as did 17 year old Daniel Axford who joins his brothers Tom & Lachlan. The Eagles sealed a resounding win over Catani in round one with a strong second half led by five goals apiece by Ben Wragg and Shaun Phelan who were ably backed by Jaxon Notman a player that looks like he will step up this year. The composure of 19 year old Bryce Joyce behind centre and the return of tough defender Keegan Bott were also big positives. The home side to prevail in a close encounter.

YARRAGON v LANG LANG

This is the SEN91.9FM broadcast match of the day. The Panthers did little to enthrall fans in the first half of the opening round but then fought the game out strongly in the second half against Trafalgar when it looked like it might be in for a hiding. Tyler Payroll in his second season with Yarragon after crossing from Nar Nar Goon reinforced he is among the best recruits to join our competition in recent years, 16 year old Liam Butterworth-Smith showed his abundant pace and veteran James Harvey still has plenty to offer in what was a disappointing first round performance. Lang Lang has no exposed form since it had the bye in round 1. The Tigers scratched and scrambled last year but didn't measure up finals material. New coach Daniel Fry, the 2019 Longwarry premiers coach will be out to see its talent is used as a collective unit. Needs a few midfielders to support Sean Dwyer and Tyler Guan if it is to be part of the finals action this year. Expect the arrival of Daniel Reid, Dylan Gallasch, Riley Dolan and Mitch Davey to add to the Tigers depth this year. The visitors to kick off their season with a victory.

CATANI v LONGWARRY

There was a lot to like about the Blues in the first half at Ellinbank before it tired in the second. With a dozen newcomers its best is still weeks away but it will be real nuisance value for many teams this year. Springvale districts ruck rover Matt Soutter-Smith, Beaconsfield ruck and forward Tyson Robinson and tall Lauchlan Gregson, who has returned and was a good target up forward

and were among those to catch the eye. The Crows drew clear in the second half against Nilma Darnum in an effort that was more workmanlike than spectacular. Darren Granger, a 33 year old forward from Stony Creek impressed with four goals and along with Braydon McHugh and Jed Serong Longwarry does have the firepower to kick big scores. Nonetheless at home and better for its first round outing I'll tip the home side to pull off an upset.

NYORA v NEERIM SOUTH

The Saints face a daunting task against the Cats on the rebound from an opening round loss to Buln Buln. Its effort at Poowong in round 1 was very pedestrian for large parts but it did finish strongly. Scott Pugh again looks like he will be the go to man inside fifty while ruckman and 2022 MVP Travis Stewart started where he left off last year winning kicks and taps all over the ground. Despite its opening round loss Neerim is still a formidable side. Bunyip recruit Jack Blakey and 19 year old Tom Crole, who missed last season through injury give the Cats an embarrassment of riches up forward. Another newcomer Ayden Ramm, the leagues U18 captain last year did not look out of place at senior level in week one. The Cats to win with plenty in reserve.

NILMA DARNUM v TRAFALGAR

The Bombers will enter unfancied against the Bloods but their opening round effort put a smile on many of its fans and insiders when it was competitive for three quarters at Longwarry. It gave every indication it is vastly improved team. Nat Campbell was outstanding as ever and given a real hand in and around the middle from Sage Tapner, who played at Yarragon in 2022. Blake Cann and Travis Dyke, who both returned over summer were busy. Trafalgar despite the loss of half a dozen quality players was never in any danger in its first round clash against Yarragon but would not be happy conceding many second half goals in a low scoring game. Mature Cranbourne recruit Curtis Barker showed plenty of footy smarts, goal sneak Matt Devon looks like a player on the rise and midfielder Blake Radford displayed the consistency that saw him come runner up in the senior club best & fairest last year. The Darno's will be plucky but the visitors should win with a few goals to spare.




