

Round 3 Preview - Football

Longwarry face a tall order in round 3 of the Parklea 2023 season when it plays host to premiers aspirants and the in form Buln Buln. Both teams enter the match with two wins from their opening two matches. The Crows will be buoyed by a second half resurgence at Catani last week when it overcame a five goal deficit at half time and the Lyrebirds will be confident after knocking off last year's premiers Neerim South in round 1 and crushing last year's preliminary finalist Ellinbank by 64 points last Saturday.

LONGWARRY v BULN BULN

Tough test for the home side. The Crows won its two matches but in unconvincing fashion against Nilma Darnum and Catani who both finished in the bottom two on the ladder last season. Twenty year old tall Adam Adamiak is a top prospect, seasoned forward recruit Darren Granger looks a real asset and will provide a good foil for Brayden McHugh who has kicked 208 goals at senior level in his 100 games since crossing from ROC in 2016. Can't fault the Lyrebirds. Reece Campbell (4 goals last week) shapes ad a big improver, 17 year old Daniel Axford has not looked out of place at senior level in his first two senior games and now veteran Mitch Nobelius who has returned to the club after 115 senior matches at Warragul has added to the Lyrebirds depth. The sound Buln Buln defence coupled with a far better midfield will see the home side does not kick a winning score.

ELLINBANK v NYORA

In the SEN Track 91.9fm broadcast match the Eagles will enter strong favourites despite struggling against Neerim South last week. Among the positives to emerge from that match for Ellinbank was the performance of Cora Lynn recruit Rylan Smith and U18 Liam Lisle. Nineteen year old defender Ryan Atherton also warrants a mention. He has been super consistent in his 22 senior matches since making his debut and has a bright future. The Saints were outclassed by Neerim last Saturday but credit to Captain Jordan Anderson who led by example, forward Nick Anderson and Coach Dylan Heylen who always puts his body on the line.

NEERIM NEERIM SOUTH v POOWONG

Similar to last year the reigning premiers showed an ever present urge to attack last week in its 93 point win over Nyora. Eleven individual goal kickers showcased its forward potency. Ruck recruit Marco Kulas, who struggled to get a regular game at Buln Buln due to the presence

of Matt Gray and Bob McCallum made his presence last week and could be an answer to one of the few areas Neerim have room for improvement. The Magpies will be fresh off the bye but its senior squad looks far inferior to that of recent seasons. Utility Tom Robertson is now an indispensable part of the team while 19 year old Zac Gray along with Mitch Van't Hof and Alex Henshall loom as likely types. On the brief exposed form the home side should win comfortably.

LANG LANG v NILMA DARNUM

After having the bye in round one the Tigers opened the season on a losing note at Yarragon last week. Kooweerup trio of recruits Luke Glassborrow, Jason Stokkel and Kalin Parker all made their presence felt and as usual Captain Josh Browne was busy around the packs but one feels Lang Lang disappointed last week. To cut Lang Lang some slack it was their first outing and should be improved for it. The Bomber whilst wooden spooners last year would be unwise to dismiss as it a vastly improved team based on its first two efforts against Longwarry and within a kick of beating Trafalgar. The Darno's must be pleased with the five goal return of Fitzroy Stars recruit John Hayes last week while there was a lot to like about newcomers Billy Jack Smith and Sage Tapner.

TRAFALGAR v CATANI

The Bloods look like they will be rebuilding after the loss of many key position and playmakers. Nevertheless it has chalked up two victories and mature Cranbourne recruit Curtis Barker is a top pick up to support this season's captain and ruckman Dylan Farrell and the ever reliable Jace and Klay Butler. Catani have improved significantly this season but the only knock on them is they have faded badly after half time in the first two rounds. The presence of new recruits Tyson Robinson, Ryan Cunningham and Matt Soutter-Smith has provided far more balance to assist regular workhorses Dylan and James Williams and Tom Keily. At home Trafalgar to win in a close contest.




