4. SECRETARY (A Bottaro-Porter):

- All Junior shirts have been organised and sent to Wash N Dry.
- Soccer balls for arrived for all Juniors as part of their registration.

5. JUNIOR COMPETITION SECRETARY (C Lawrence):

- 253 Junior registrations in total with breakdown 4-5 yo = 26; 6-8 yo = 83; 9-10yo = 40; 11-16 yo = 92; 17-18yo = 12
- Junior registrations closing on 22 April to form teams. However, late registrations accepted but no guarantee of which team they are placed in.
- Peak Hill Juniors will be registering through PDASA but with their own name.
- K Noble- Eugowra will have Junior teams for U6, and maybe U8. They have businesses as sponsors for shirts, jumpers and kits.

6. OPEN LADIES COMPETITION SECRETARY (L Lovell):

- Team nominations received – 5 teams (Raptors, Kookaburras, Redbacks, Cougars, Coyotes). Forbes have emailed to state that they may consider entering a team in 2024.
- Structure of Competition - do we progress with 5 teams or wait? LASA has 7 Mens teams with a pre-season competition (over 2 weeks on Sunday) which could include Ladies. D Parker stated pre-season to start April 30 (20 mins halves) and combine Mens and Ladies to promote more players to join.
