

# League Tributes



## THE LEAGUE EXECUTIVE WOULD LIKE TO PAY THEIR RESPECTS TO THE FOLLOWING PEOPLE.

The EDFNL league executive would like to pay tribute to the following people who all passed away over the last 12 months. All were popular, organised and dependable and their outstanding commitment to their clubs and in the case of Russell - the independent tribunal – made a not only their clubs but the league a far superior organisation.

### GRAEME BROWNE

**DOB 3/5/1950 – Passed 2/5/2022**

Graeme was an EDFL life member. He started with Buln Buln in 1965 and won both Reserves and 3rds B & F's for Buln. He played over 200 senior games in a career of more than 250 games for Buln before moving to Nilma Darnum in 1981 as a 30 year old. He played 128 senior games at Darnum in a total of 152 for the club and retired in 1989. He served 6 years on the committee and would do anything asked of him. He taught himself to read and write and had his own business Browns Appliance Service and there wasn't an electrical appliance he couldn't fix!

Unfortunately Graeme lost his battle with blood cancer last year after having a stroke years earlier. He was a complete family man who loved peace & quiet but then again loved a chat.

### GEOFF GLOVER

**DOB 29/9/1930- Passed 22/1/2023**

The EDFNL (formerly EDFL) Board of Management (BOM) was sad to learn of the passing of Nyora Football Netball Club stalwart Geoff Glover early this year. Geoff devoted five and a half decades to the Saints and will be remembered as the heart and soul of the club and a loyal club person without peer. His presence will be missed by all at Nyora and the league football fraternity.

### ADRIAN (AIDEE) PRATT

**DOB 28/11/1928 – Passed 29/7/2022**

Incredibly Aidee had a 77 year involvement with the Ellinbank FNC. He was a player for 28 years between 1946 & 1974 and was part of their 1953-55 three peat. He also accumulated 17 years in Secretary and Treasurer roles for the club. Aidee was an Ellinbank life member and in 2007 was awarded life membership of the Ellinbank & District Football League. He received a AFL 50 year volunteer service award and as the Ellinbank FNC historian he was well-known for his record keeping and recollection of the old football tales.

### HEATHER FORT

**DOB 3/6/1948 – Passed 28/10/2022**

Heather worked on the Poowong gate with her husband and league life member Keith for over 25 years. She loudly supported the Magpies netballers for over 30 years, including many games as scorer. Renowned for making a cake or slice for afternoon tea for every home game during her time with the club and was a member of the Thursday night ladies crew for many years along with "assistant" treasurer to Keith for 16 years. Heather played netball for a couple of seasons until a knee injury forced her into retirement. She was always well organised and published the Poowong FNC newsletter for 10 years prior to the introduction of the Follower and would wash trainer's uniforms, dressing gowns, runners gear and any players clothing that was left behind after each game.

### RUSSELL PORCH

**DOB 12/10/1941 - Passed 15/10/2022**

Russell was an honorary independent tribunal member who living to 81 years of age devoted over half his life to the tribunal - a thoroughly outstanding long term commitment. Russell started with the tribunal in 1979 and was well respected by players, umpires and officials for his preparedness and impartiality.

# Round 4 Preview - Football



The most fascinating match in round 4 of the Parklea EDFNL season will see Catani meet old sparring partner Lang Lang. These two teams have built up a strong rivalry since the Tigers joined the league in 2000. Fans of both teams have been treated to many thrilling contests and like many a local derby the favoured team as often lowered its colours which sets the scene for another intriguing contest.

### CATANI v LANG LANG

Catani has shifted up a few gears this season and is far better unit but has yet to put together more than two good quarters. One thinks if it can produce three good quarters this is a very winnable game. Newcomers Tyson Robinson, Ryan Cunningham, Jack Roberts and veteran Tooradin recruit Adam Splatt have all ensued the Blues are more competitive. Lang Lang its second match for the year last week looked far more settled against the improved Nilma Darnum after a rather pedestrian effort for the first three quarters in its first match at Yarragon. Ex Catani tall Mitch Davey looks a formidable target. Josh Browne never plays a bad game while Dylan Gallasch, Chaise Jordan and Riley Dolan have proved to be good picks up. Fancy the visitors in a thriller.

### BULN BULN v TRAFALGAR

Buln Buln will be feeling pretty chipper about themselves. Three straight wins and yet to put their best side on the park. It has demonstrated tremendous depth with Nathan Tutton winning the ANZAC medal at Longwarry last week while ex Nilma and Bunyip runner Blake Cann won plenty of possessions, former junior star Brendan Doyle and Jarred Doyle are among many improvers in the Lyrebird outfit. Trafalgar is not the side it was last year. Quality recruit Curtis Barker – a two time B&F at Cranbourne goes some way to replace the experience that left over summer. Dylan Farrell who won the ANZAC medal v Catani last week has stepped up in the captaincy role and done well and veteran Matt Swenson still shows craftiness around goals. Buln Buln comfortably accounted for Trafalgar twice in 2022 so it is hard to imagine the visitors will turn the table on exposed form in 2023.

### NYORA v LONGWARRY

This is the SEN Track 91.9fm Latrobe Valley 'match of the day.' The Saints have fallen away badly in its last two outings. While a sample of three matches is small similar to last year it appears too few are asked to do too much. Dylan Heylen, Jordan Anderson, Kallon Rigby and Captain Sam Dixon have all set the example but others must lift. A win is not beyond the home side though if it can put together more than two good quarters. For Longwarry two

big stories came out of last week. The positive was the return of promising youngster Fintan Fox. It appears he has made a strong recovery after sustaining an injury at training that saw him miss the U18 grand final after he kicked 10 goals in the Qualifying final last year. On the negative side star veteran Russell Lehman strolled off the field early last week with what looked a recurrence of the nagging calf injury that has hindered him in recent times and if reports are correct he may well have played his last game of what has been a stellar career.

### POOWONG v ELLINBANK

These two sides last meet in the 2022 elimination final. The Magpies went in hot favourites only to be rolled by the Eagles who found form over last year's final series and went on to make a preliminary final appearance were they narrowly lost to the eventual premiers Neerim South. On evidence both teams are not travelling as well as they were last year. Not a lot for Poowong supporters to be enthused so far. Captain Jack Hazendonk and now a three time Alf Walton medallist showed the way last week but the Maggies look to be swimming against the tide as it has lost a fair few quality players. Tom Robertson and Mitch Vant'hof have contested strongly.

For Ellinbank, Tom Johnson may be 34 years of age but is still invaluable as a 'Mr Fixit' in any position. Cora Lynn recruit Rylan Smith has given a good account of himself and Jaxon Notman with nine goals is having a break out year.

### NILMA DARNUM v YARRAGON

Nilma Darnum will be gunning for their first win since 2021. Sage Tapner who played at Yarragon last year has proved the best of the Bombers recruits setting up plenty of forward moves this season and as usual Nathan Campbell, Nick Carrigy and Jeremy Jarred have been consistent as ever. Yarragon is looking better than last year. It has two real goers on Tyler Payroli and Taylor Rainey. Hampton Park recruit Travis Davis provided a good target in round two and there was a lot to like about tall Mooroopna newcomer Ryan Devine. Yarragon to scrape across the line. NEERIM SOUTH – BYE




## FOOTBALL



I played football for Longwarry - which at the time was in the West Gippsland Football League - and attended Drouin High School. After playing only five games in my debut season at Hawthorn I established myself in the first team in 1970. The following year I was chosen for Victoria, winning the Simpson Medal for the best on ground in the match against Western Australia in Perth. I was a three time premierships player with the Hawks, won the mark of the year award three times and an Australian hall of fame inductee. I was the inaugural coach of the Brisbane Bears.

## This week's question?

My club of origin was the Warragul Guls. I played at Gippsland Power and was drafted to the Western Bulldogs with pick 13 in the 1999 National Draft. After spending much of the 2000 season developing my slim frame I made my debut in Round 19 against Carlton at Princes Park, gathering 13 disposals and kicking a goal in a thrilling 3-point victory. In 2001 I was nominated for the AFL Rising Star award in round 16. Renowned for silky skills and leadership qualities I was a versatile player, equally capable of playing in attack or in defence depending on the situation. I played 312 matches with the Western Bulldogs, kicking 183 goals, represented Victoria, and was a two-time All Australian. Due to an ACL injury I did not play in the clubs 2016 premierships team and retired in 2017.
