



AREA AGREEMENT – MAJOR LEAGUE/FEMALE LEAGUE

An agreement between the Kyabram District League and the Murray Football League

This agreement is signed pursuant to AFL Victoria Country Rules and Regulations pertaining to clearances and permits and in particular clause 2.10 – Area Permits, whereby an interchange of players between clubs of the abovementioned leagues may take place without clearance or permits and is subject to any provisions contained within this agreement.

PROVIDED HOWEVER:

- (i) That this Agreement is in force for the current season only.
- (ii) That the player(s) concerned are acquainted with AFL Victoria Country regulations 2.1 and 2.5 regarding one day permits to Major Leagues and eight (8) matches.
- (iii) That prior to each match played, the player shall obtain written permission to do so from his parent club. **All permits shall be a “Type 2 – Interchange Permit” and must be approved by the ‘from’ club before the player participates.**
- (iv) With the exception of players of junior age competitions, players of any club having a bye will not be allowed to play with another club on that day, unless he has previously played with that club in the current season under this agreement. The club playing the player from the other League shall show his registered club on the match team sheet.
Players who are eligible for thirds (U18,U17) that play in the Senior Grade competitions are not to be classified as players of Junior age competitions.
- (v) That this agreement cannot be altered unless agreed to by the Area Manager.

LOCAL CONDITIONS:

1. INTERCHANGE OF PLAYERS

Major League players are permitted 6 permits to play in the District League H&A Thirds (U18) Grade

- The total number of permits must not exceed 6
- Permits are not permitted for senior or reserve grade. MFL players are permitted to play in the KDL on permit when their home club has a BYE (this includes General League BYES)

District league players are permitted 6 permits to play in the Major League H&A THIRDS (U17) grade provided:

- The total number of permits must not exceed 6.
- KDL are permitted to play in the MFL Thirds on permit when their home club has a BYE (this includes General League BYES)

District league players are permitted 4 permits to play in the Major League Seconds (Reserves) grade provided:

- The total number of permits must not exceed 4

2. FINALS PERMITS & ELIGIBILITY

NO permits are issued to play finals in either League.

3. GAMES PER DAY/WEEKEND

Players permitted to **ONLY PLAY ONE (1)** game per weekend.

4. NUMBER OF PERMITS

District/Major League Thirds (U18,U17) – Teams are only permitted **6** permit players in any one match.

Major League Reserves – Teams are only permitted **4** permit players in any one match.

5. REPORTED PLAYERS

A player playing on permit that is reported shall face the Tribunal of the League of which the offence was committed. Any penalty that is imposed shall apply in all competitions.

6. PERMIT BREACHES

Any breach of Permit arrangements and agreements will be referred to the AFL Victoria Country Rule 1.3 – Penalty for playing ineligible or unregistered players

7. SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

- Clubs are reminded to abide by local league by-laws that may be in place in regards to number of permits permitted arrangements i.e. overage/medical etc.
- KDL are permitted to play in the MFL Thirds on permit when their home club has a BYE (this includes General League BYES)
- MFL are permitted to play in KDL Thirds on permit when their home club has a BYE (this includes General League BYES)

This agreement is valid and will remain current unless endorsed by an AFL Victoria Country Region Manager.
