

Round 7 Preview - Football

Trafalgar host Neerim Neerim South in the showpiece match in round 7 of the Parklea home and away season this Saturday. Many pundits felt the Bloods would struggle to make the finals this season, but it has silenced the critics so far. The SEN Track 91.9FM Latrobe Valley broadcast team will head to Lang Lang for the Tigers clash against Poowong and a must win game for both to stay in touch with the top five.

TRAFALGAR v NEERIM NEERIM SOUTH

Trafalgar have snuck up to 2nd on the ladder and will be out to make a statement it is the real deal if it can topple the Cats and the reigning premiers. Wily veteran Matt Swenson (17 goals) has provided a good target, ruckman Dylan Farrell is always a formidable presence and Jace Butler and Mitch Virtue never fail to deliver. Neerim South led Longwarry on a merry dance last week. Its forward potency was on display with a spread of 11 individuals goal kickers. Tyssen Morrow and Jack Blakey have offered great drive this season. Chris Charles and Copper Clancy steady defence while athletic tall Marco Kulas is showing the form he always promised. The superior firepower of the visitors should see it prevail in a thriller.

LANG v POOWONG LANG

This pits the 7th placed Tigers versus the 8th placed Magpies. As their ladder positions suggest both have made an uncertain start. Aside from talls Joe Dalgliesh, Mitch Davey and Lachlan Barwick along with recruit Chaise Jordan (14 goals) too many others are under performing. Similarly, the Magpies have relied heavily on Steve McInnes, Tom Robertson, Jack Hazendonk and youngster Alex Henshall –who shows plenty of potential – for inspiration. Home ground advantage should see the Tigers victors.

LONGWARRY v ELLINBANK

The Crows effort last week against Neerim South is best forgotten when it folded like deckchairs. Among the better aspects to emerge for Longwarry this season is the vast improvement in tall Angus Adamiak, youngster Cooper Brown is a constant source of strength, Burnie recruit Brayden Chandler and journeyman Darren Granger know the tools of the trade and Braydon McHugh and Jedd

Serong have combined to kick 28 goals between them. The Eagles are travelling nicely. It will enter refreshed after the bye last Saturday before a victory over Neerim South. Youngster Bryce Joyce has ball sense that belie his age, at the other end of the age spectrum Tom Johnson continues to excel in key roles and Keegan Bott who returned this year still has shown he has something to offer in defence in a side that is teaming well.

YARRAGON v NYORA

The Panthers came back down to earth with a thud last Saturday after a 76 point loss to Buln Buln. It will be better for the experience and must be heartened by the consistent form this year of Mooroopna recruit Lachie Devine (who missed last week), Tyler Payroli, Zac Hogton and the emerging Liam Butterworth-Smith. The Saints will enter buoyed by opening their winning account last Saturday against Lang Lang. Coach Dylan Heylen, Captain Sam Dixon and the Anderson's Jordan and Nick all led by example and have all season. It is not without a chance but think a win this week is a bridge too far.

NILMA DARNUM v BULN BULN

The Bombers remain the only team yet to win a match and the Lyrebirds the only team not to lose a match. Nonetheless Nilma Darnum has shown definite improvement this year and the likes of Jeremy Jarred, Sage Tapner, Chris Demicoli and Lucas Maffei have given fans plenty to be encouraged. Buln Buln's success has been founded on balance across all lines. To cite out a few individuals' newcomers Riley Rundell and Dylan Cann (who will play against his former club where he played 87 senior matches) have added pace and run while Nathan Tutton bores in and along with Reece Campbell and Brendan Wall the later three have all shown good improvement this year.




