## Round 8 Preview - Football

Ellinbank, second on the ladder play host to the third placed Trafalgar in the Parklea EDFNL round 8 match of the day. The two teams last met in the 2022 1stSemi-Final when the Eagles prevailed by 25 points to bring an end to the Bloods finals prospects. It is the SEN Track 91.9fm broadcast match.

### ELLINBANK v TRAFALGAR

With five wins a % nudging 200 the Eagles are playing with real self-assurance. The old heads in the team led by coach Jake Harper, former mentor Ben Wragg, Tom Johnson, Anthony Battista and Liam Anderson play the percentages well and never put in a bad game. There was a lot to like about the Bloods in the first half last week against Neerim South but it faded in the second. Once again Jace Butler was outstanding, captain Dylan Farrell and Cranbourne recruit Curtis Barker, both prominent, and one would think this trio would occupy the top three positions in their club best and fairest after seven rounds. The Bankers at home likely to be a tad too strong.

### NEERIM SOUTH v LANG LANG

The Cats haven't yet hit the dizzy heights they reached in 2022 but with the return of captain and midfield dynamo Kody Wilson over the last fortnight expect Neerim to lift in the upcoming weeks. While the Cats forwards often win the accolades their defence led by Alex Johnson, Matt Edwards, Tom Muir and Chris Charles represent a tight back six. As their ladder position suggests Lang Lang has disappointed. Missing the ruck division of Joe Dalglish, Sean Dwyer, Tyler Guan and Daniel Reid last week it could not measure up against Poowong. On the bright side Kaden Finlay-Smith shapes as an improved player and U18s Liam Casey and Rylen Cranton who have made their debut over the last fortnight and have stamped themselves as players with a future.

### POOWONG v YARRAGON

A tight finish is expected as this match pits 5th v 6th on the ladder. The Magpies are not the team they were last year but showed some encouraging signs brushing aside Lang Lang by 10 goals last Saturday. Twenty-year-old Mitch De Kleuver has stepped up, Jack Hazendonk continues to excel and has been ably supported in the midfield by Steven McInnes. The Panthers have only kicked 14 goals in their

last three outings. Missing Tom Dovaston and with another tall Mitch Jolly injured early last week it lacked firepower despite some good forward work by Hampton Park recruit Trav Davis. The home team to win.

### NYORA v NILMA DARNUM

The Saints sit 9th on the ladder but will be aiming to win three on the trot for the first time since rounds 13,14 &15 of the 2019 season after successive victories over Lang Lang and Yarragon. Should it have beaten Poowong and Longwarry – it lost by six points to both – it could have found itself in the top five. The Heylen's Dylan and Jesse, Jordan Anderson and diminutive Jack Rosenow always have a red hot go and Max Mattock has proved a good pick up from Phillip Island since he arrived last year. The Bombers are the only team yet to open its winning account. While it lost by 64 points to the ladder leaders Buln Buln last Saturday – a mark of its improvement was that in 2022 it lost to the Lyrebirds by 184 points. Seb Crowle, Travis Dyke and John Hayes all showed plenty to assist regular war horses Nat Campbell and Nick Carrigy. Nyora won't get everything its own way but will win.

### BULN BULN v CATANI

Hard to fault the undefeated Lyrebirds. Such is their versatility regular stopper Shaun Beecroft enjoyed a stint up forward last Saturday and bagged five majors. The sheer class of Matt Gray, Bob McCallum and Hayden Baker to name just a few will see the home side comfortably source the four match points on offer. The Blues cracked it for their first win against Nilma Darnum in round 6 before having the bye last week. Tyson Robinson was once again in the thick of things, veteran Adam Splatt has proved an astute pick and forward target while newcomers John Massett, Tom Carpenter and Jack Roberts have enjoyed some productive games.


