

Round 9 Preview - Football

As we enter round 9 of the Parklea EDFNL home and away season - based on percentage - three teams Buln Buln, who have the bye this week, Ellinbank and Neerim South all look to have a stranglehold on the top three positions which provide a double chance come finals time.

One of the more fascinating matches this Saturday is the SEN Track 91.9fm broadcast match between Catani and the ever-improving Nyora who have their sights set on a top five berth and will be gunning for four wins in a row. Expect it to be a keenly and closely contested affair.

LANG LANG v ELLINBANK

At the start of the season many folks would have thought this match to be a potential blockbuster however for the home side there has been little to be enthused about and in contrast the Eagles have left little room for criticism. Lang Lang has missed a good deal of its midfield this season and so it has not measured up against the top sides. On the plus side newcomers Lachlan Trudgeon, Kalin Parker and Chaise Jordan have looked the goods in a team that has failed to link the lines enough times. Nineteen-year-old Eagle Bryce Joyce has taken his game to a new level and is a potential star in a team that is humming along. Ellinbank has continued where it left off last year when it had a strong finals series only losing in the preliminary final to eventual premier Neerim South and who it beat in round 5 this year to stamp it a genuine flag prospect once again.

TRAFALGAR v LONGWARRY

The Bloods will be happy to be fourth on the ladder with five wins but still a big question marks hover over its ability to beat the three sides above it. The return of Damian Mann last week will assist their forward potency while Blake Radford, Jamie Hines along with ex Cranbourne duo Daniel Baker and Curtis Barker have all laboured hard with good success. Nineteen-year-old defender Hardy Kenny shapes as a good long term prospect. The Crows have hit a rough patch over the last month. It had the bye last week but prior to that it was guilty of poor finishing kicking 10 goals 23 behinds in three consecutive losses after its last win over Nyora in round 4. Longwarry has suffered too many inexplicable lapses over the course of its games.

YARRAGON v NEERIM NEERIM SOUTH

The Panthers will be in for a grueling time against the inform Cats. It has yet to show its best this season. Former Mooropna pair Lachlan and Ryan Devine and Taylor Rainey and Captain Tyler Payrolli continue to offer strong performances, but it is hard to see how the home side will

master the miserly Neerim South defence. With the return of Kody Wilson and Chris Urie in recent weeks Neerim is now looking imposing after three thumping wins over Longwarry, Trafalgar and Lang Lang. On exposed form Yarragon will do well if it can keep the end margin to less than six goals.

NILMA DARNUM v POOWONG

The Bombers are yet to win a match but it is a vastly improved side having averaged over 50 points per week this season as opposed to only 26 points in 2022. Last week at Nyora it managed to kick 13 goals with Fitzroy Stars recruit John Hayes (5 goals) and Billy Jack Smith and Jack Jarred showing they can have a strong forward presence if they get enough feed from the midfielders. The Magpies have quietly slipped up to fifth on the table with little fanfare. It is improving but far from convincing as a genuine finals prospect. Ruck Conor Cunningham has regularly wielded his influence, 19-year-old Alex Henshall looks well-schooled as does Mitch Van't Hof now one of the teams mainstays.

CATANI v NYORA

Off field the Blues will celebrate their 2013 & 1953 premiership reunion on Saturday while on field their charges will be out to show they are not done with yet. Recruit Tyson Robinson has put in a lot of tradesman like efforts while his former Beaconsfield team mate Callum May showed plenty in his Catani debut last week. Mitch Latimer, who has returned to the club has also proved a good addition so to other newbies Ryan Cunningham, John Massett and Jack Roberts who have all had their moments. The Saints are the big mover now up to 7th on the ladder on the back of three wins on the trot. Ruck Trav Stewart showed he was a real jack in the box hauling in some terrific marks last week and with 10 goals this year he also doubles as a forward threat. Phillip Island recruits Rhys Grange-Lylak, Josh Ryan and Connor Thompson have added pace and run and more depth while Jono Hewitt and Marvin Sellars are on the improve nonetheless on a bid day for Catani I'll tip them to pull off an upset in a nail biter.




