

# EDFNL Mid Season Report



Here we are at the halfway mark of the Parklea EDFNL 2023 season and the new EDFNL Board of Management (BOM) is so far pleased with proceedings. Importantly good numbers have been reported by most clubs across all grades of football and netball and casting an eye over the ladders suggests plenty of competitive matches among all levels junior and senior. On the downside however, around the football fields there has been far too many reports of poor behaviour from players, officials and to a lesser extent spectators. This is somewhat uncharacteristic after good behaviour from all parties over the last five years or so. We have a terrific family friendly league lets all play our part to keep it that way.

Once again thank you to all clubs and parents for their acceptance of the junior catch matches. While these extra matches can be inconvenient, they are all about maximising the amount games our youngsters play – essential for their development and the healthiness of the league.

At senior level football wise there is clearly five top sides but I predict a few upsets in the run up to the final round while in the other three grades the top five positions are yet to be all settled which means their will be plenty of exciting matches in the lead up to the finals.

On the netball front new Directors Karen Porter and Meaghan Newitt must also be pleased with the competitiveness across their grades. Similarly, the top five in all six grades are far from finalised. Last Saturday the reigning A grade premiers Neerim South put themselves in a strong position to go back-to-back after beating Nima Darnum in a replay of last year's grand final. I also see the Netball Victoria Association Championships took place on 4th June at Moe. Well done to all the players who earned the honour of representing the league and a thank you to the coaches and umpires. The feedback was all teams performed well especially our U13s who were runners up. The players looked terrific in their new uniforms and a big thank you to the Baw Baw Shire for the grant we used to purchase the new

outfits. On the junior football front the EDFNL will again participate in the Gippsland U18 carnival – this year on 28 June. Like last year there is no Gippy U16 carnival but to offset this and develop our U16s we held another East v West match at Lang Lang during the week and will play an Interleague match against the West Gippsland FNC also at Lang Lang on the 5th July.

Our finals start on Saturday 26 August with the 2023 Parklea Grand Final to be played on Saturday 16 September. The finals venues will be announced early July.

On the administration side this year we have a two newcomers Tim Cosstick, who is doing an outstanding job assisting clubs with the Play HQ system and Tanya Helliari, who has refreshed and revitalised our social media. You may or not know but the Follower is now available on our league website and Instagram and via a QR at each ground thanks to Tanya. Very soon we will have a new league website and a new competition to announce on Instagram for EDFNL junior players.

# Round 11 Preview - Football



The stakes are high for the sixth placed and improving Lang Lang this week in the 11th round of the Parklea EDFNL home and away season when it faces a big test against the fourth placed Trafalgar.

By 4:30pm on Saturday all should know if the Tigers, who have been disappointing this season is a viable finals contender. It promises to be a close match on exposed form. Over the last fortnight Trafalgar beat Longwarry by 15 points and last week Lang Lang beat Longwarry by six points.

## LANG LANG v TRAFALGAR

Could regular defender and odd job man Lachlan Barwick be the answer to the Tigers goal kicking woes? Without the spring heeled Daniel Lewis this season, who steered through 50 majors last year it has not had a target to kick to. Last Saturday though the versatile Barwick moved forward to bag five. With two wins in a row Lang Lang has moved up to sixth on the ladder. Trafalgar struggled to brush aside the underperforming Longwarry in round 9 but will enter the game refreshed after the bye last Saturday. It has lost to the top three teams but accounted for all six teams below it. Lang Lang will need to keep close tabs on new Bloods Curtis Barker and Daniel Baker along with usual suspects Jace Butler and Matt Swenson. Being a massive game for the home side I'll pick it to rise to the occasion.

## YARRAGON v LONGWARRY

Fair to say both are beset by poor form. Both enter the match with five consecutive losses. After a promising start the Panthers have badly fallen away and the same can be said for the Crows. Among the shining lights for Yarragon are Tyler Payroli, Zac Hogton and Ryan Devine but they need far more to make a contribution if they hope to redeem their sliding top five prospects. Like Yarragon, Longwarry can statistically make the finals, but it too looks way off the pace. Mature recruit Darren Granger has proved a top choice as captain, youngster Cooper Brown a star of the future while key forward Jedd Serong always proves a big threat but in recent times has been starved of supply and quality delivery. At home the Panthers to be a mite to good in a nail biter.

## NILMA DARNUM v ELLINBANK

The Bombers and last year's wooden spooners have fought commendably this year to be competitive but last Saturday against the Neerim South the reigning premiers it crumbled badly. Hope this is not a sign of things to come. Little for the Darno's to be excited about aside from Fitzroy Stars recruit John Hayes who kicked their only two goals and who has kicked 17 for the year in his matches. It goes without saying coach Paul Alger has more than enough experience to instil in his battlers the importance to earn respect this week

against another top side. Ellinbank must be happy they are well entrenched for a double chance at the halfway mark of the season. Ex Cora Lynn back man Rylan Smith must surely be among the best recruits of the season while Shaun Phelan has kicked 31 goals but first year coach Jake Harper must be more pleased that everyone is chipping in demonstrated by 11 individual goal kickers last week. Juniors Liam Lisle and Logan Joyce have shown enough talent to let know we will hear a lot more about these two in upcoming years.

## CATANI v NEERIM NEERIM SOUTH

Got to give credit to Catani that since its bad loss to Lang Lang in round 4 it has battled gamely against all comers and again last week it pressed hard to only go down by 10 points at Poowong. Beaconsfield recruit Callum May has been prominent in and around the forward line in his three appearances. Coach Luke Young must be impressed by their workmanlike ethos despite only two wins. Neerim South ticks all the boxes and dines out on lesser sides which poses a problem for the home side. The Cats creamed Nilma last week and look to be approaching their best. Expect captain Kody Wilson and his midfield mates to feed his forwards with more than enough supply to win comfortably.

## BULN BULN v POOWONG

For the Lyrebirds last week, it was another day at the office and another win. Matt Gray was in vintage form and there would not be too many better 38-year-olds going around in country football and certainly not with his athleticism. Aside from its four-point opening round win against Neerim Neerim South it has not looked like losing. Poowong is making serious progress. It has won four in a row but is a side that has to graft out victories. It looks like what it lacks in talent it makes up with a good game plan and structure. Ruckman Conor Cunningham, now 34 years of age is still moving around with youthful exuberance, Jack Hafendonk a real busy body, Andrew Logan a key to their defence with his intercepting ability and experience while many of its lesser lights the likes of Damon Hansen and Micah Williams regularly play important roles.




