Round 12 Preview - Football

Buln Buln's clash with Neerim Neerim South is unquestionably the match of the day. It will pit the undefeated Lyrebirds against last year's premiers. The match will also arouse strong interest for not only is it a replay of the 2022 grand final and when the Cats won by a solitary point, but little appears to separate the two sides in recent times. In the opening round this season Buln Buln beat Neerim South by four points. If you're not at the ground or even if you are, tune in to SEN Track 91.9fm Latrobe Valley for a kick-by-kick coverage. This is by far the best round of the season. Every match could go either way.

BULN BULN v NEERIM NEERIM SOUTH

The home side is well on track for the minor premiership and will be out to maintain its perfect winning record this season. Expect a bit of needle between the two teams given their rivalry of late. Both know each other well so perhaps it will be the newcomers this year who make a difference. The Lyrebirds have added the pace of Riley Rundell, the ball winning ability of Brenda Wall, experience of Mitch Nobelius and youth of Daniel Axford to last year's model. The Cats have a big acquisition in Jack Blakey along with Ayden Ramm an emerging star, and forward Tom Crole has recovered from injury. As the home side has not fielded anywhere near its best twenty-one in recent weeks got a hunch the visitors will inflict Buln Buln's first loss in a heart stopper.

YARRAGON v TRAFALGAR

The Panthers buoyed by last week's victory over Longwarry and with finals aspirations still alive will throw down the gauntlet to the Bloods. What must be tugging at their mind though is since Trafalgar joined the league it has met Yarragon on four occasions and won every time. Panther newcomer Trav Davis has proved to be one of the recruits of the season while Lachlan Shaw and Sam Van Der Zalm both returned to their best last week to add support to usual prime movers Tyler Payroli, Taylor Rainey and Lachie Devine. Hard to make a lot of Trafalgar's win last week other than it was gritty. In a wind marred match at Lang Lang large portions of the match drifted into paralysis. The game of Captain Dylan Farrell, and Butler boys Jace and Klay deserve recognition for their ability to adapt when most players didn't. I'll tip an upset. NILMA DARNUM v LONGWARRY

The Bombers did regroup a bit against Ellinbank last Saturday after it was smashed by Neerim South a week earlier. In truth it has a long way to go to win against any team other than one in the lower rungs of the ladder. However, this week it is presented with a big chance for the Crows are playing like a team out of touch. For Nilma, ex Nyora premiership ruckman Nick Carrigy has been a real workhorse since he arrived in

2019 and Jeremy Jarred, Nat Campbell and Oxley Huson never play a bad game. Mal Hunter has also made his presence up forward. The Crows are just treading water. If not for the likes of young gun Cooper Brown, mature recruit Darren Granger and in recent weeks Angus Young and Jedd Serong its losing margins over the last six weeks would have been worse. Longwarry should win but it would not be a real surprise if Nilma produce a shock and their first victory for the season.

CATANI v ELLINBANK

The Blues have a harder edge this season and are starting to play with more fusion under new coach Luke Young and will be no pushovers. It gave good as it got last week against the in form Neerim South who only drew clear late. Catani has far more depth this season with the likes of tall utility Lauchlan Gregson, Jake Roberts, Tom Carpenter, Jalen Atkins and Callum May to name just a few. Ellinbank just keeps winning. Looks like a team that is better than the sum of its parts. While recruit Ryland Smith has won plenty of kudos, Ryan Atherton, Liam Anderson and coach Jake Harper make up one of, if not the most unheralded backlines in the league. The visitors in another tight game.

NYORA v POOWONG

The Saints were outclassed in their last match against Buln Buln prior to the bye last week. After three wins on the trot, it has tapered off with two losses in a row. Captain Dylan Heylen has strived well, Scott Pugh (17 goals) has played a key role in attack along with Nick Anderson (12) while Travis Stewart always catches the eye but too many others have lacked the consistency or class to make the Saints a winning threat each week - especially against the top five teams. Poowong is now a top five side and making inroads. To lose at Buln Buln last week by only 17 points is no disgrace. Its defence is always accountable but it must crave for a key target up forward for its leading goalkicker is midfield dynamo Jack Hazendonk (17 goals) followed by Alex Henshall (13) and Will Robertson (11). Expect the Saints to have their moments but the visitors to win with a bit to spare.

EDFNL Netball Season Update



Now that 11 rounds of EDFNL netball have been played, the back end of the season is going to be a belter if the first half is anything to go by.

The fixture could come into play with who plays teams twice and who doesn't with finals spots up for grabs in all grades.

The A Grade ladder is extremely interesting as the four teams below ladder leader Neerim South all have one less win than the team above them – an unusual situation to be in at the halfway point, but almost perfect if you were doing seeding!

Neerim South have continued their unbeaten streak from last year with now at least 30 wins on the trot. Talent oozes across the court lead by Christie Urie as they have a full contingent of points after playing everyone once. They have had some big wins, but the last couple of weeks have provided some closer than usual scorelines. They will no doubt be there when it counts.

Nilma Darnum have recorded just the one loss to Neerim South, losing the Grand Final replay by just 14 goals – only a break or two each quarter the difference in the end. Injuries may be the only thing that can prevent Nilma from getting back to the big dance.

Ellinbank sit in third spot, two wins behind top having only lost to Neerim by 31 but Nilma Darnum just last week by 3 goals. Ellinbank have a blend of talented youth and experience on the court, but the kids certainly know how to play the game and will be a force to come.

As the pattern continues, Trafalgar in fourth spot have lost to the three teams above them but by only 1 goal to Nilma and 6 to Ellinbank. Since entering the competition Trafalgar have been a competitive unit, it will be whether they can get the break on the day and maintain a lead against Nilma or Ellinbank.

Buln Buln sit in fifth spot having lost to the teams above but beating the teams below. They were lucky to get over a fast finishing Catani in Round 8 winning by just 3 goals and will need to find an upset win to ensure they remain ahead of the Blues come finals time.

Catani in 6th and Lang Lang in 7th have the same record beating the teams below but drawing when they faced each other. It will be interesting to see who gets the win next time they meet and whether one of them can get over Buln Buln to claim 5th spot. Catani's percentage is better than both Lang Lang and Buln, so it will be a tight finish come Round 20.

Longwarry have just the three wins for the season but have been competitive in most games and will keep looking towards the future as they continually develop younger players.

Yarragon are a Club who are desperate to improve and will be looking for more wins this half of the season, while Nyora and Poowong like Yarragon both have just one win for the season and will want to circle the games they play each other when they can get a win on the board.

Neerim South still looks like the team to beat for A Grade, they are clearly the best in the league, but anything can happen in the theatre of sport with the four or five teams below them all wanting to be the first to claim the four points when they meet next.

B Grade is a race between three with Ellinbank, Buln Buln and Trafalgar all on the same points with nine wins for the year and just percentage separating them. Ellinbank's percentage is by far superior and will be a force to reckon with come finals time. Buln Buln have always been thereabouts when it comes to B Grade and will be looking for that elusive win and will want to taste victory when playing Ellinbank while Trafalgar can do the same on their day as well.

C Grade has Ellinbank as ladder leaders (of course) but there's a few clubs hot on their heels. Catani upset them in Round 1 for their only loss to date, but it probably spurred them on to ensure their season prepares them for their 7th Premiership in a row. Buln Buln and Neerim South will also want to spoil the Ellinbank party so the second half of the season will be interesting for this grade.

The 17&Under ladder is another close one with Catani and Longwarry leading the way with just one loss each – Catani to Longwarry (by 1 goal) and Longwarry to third placed Ellinbank by 6. It's hard to see anyone other than these three teams who have talent all over the court move from the top three spots, it will be just in what order by Round 20.

Buln Buln are the standout in the 15s, undefeated to date with both Yarragon and Poowong two wins behind them. 4th and 5th spot are definitely up for grabs between Longwarry, Nilma Darnum, and Trafalgar who are all separated by percentage and Catani in 7th spot just one win behind. The second half of the season will definitely break some hearts of the young players when the pressure is on to win games.

It's Buln Buln again who are undefeated in the 13&Under grade sitting on top of the ladder. Catani in second have only lost to the Lyrebirds but have a better percentage, so it will be an interesting game when they meet again in Round 19. The next few spots are up for grabs with Longwarry and Poowong a chance on their day to upset the leading two.

Whatever grade you look at when it comes to netball, there will be plenty of competition across the EDFNL on the netball court. The second half of the season will shape the ladders in all grades for a highly entertaining season and finals series.


