Round 15 Preview - Football

Round 15 of the Parklea EDFNL home and away season will shed plenty of light on whether the third placed Trafalgar is a genuine top three prospect. It will have to pull out all stops when it hosts the ladder leaders and flag favourites Buln Buln who have only lost one match this season and has a habit of crushing inferior sides and something it hasn't often done in recent seasons. The SEN broadcast team will be down the road at Yarragon where Nilma Darnum, who only went down by 8 points against Lang Lang last Saturday will be out to open their winning account for the season.

TRAFALGAR v BULN BULN

The Bloods just do what they must do to win matches all be it unconvincingly for large tracts of many games. This will be a litmus test at where they are at. Ruck Dylan Farrell has proved a top leader and mature recruits Daniel Baker and Curtis Barker make up for a lot of the experience lost over summer. Mitch Virtue never plays a bad game and Hardy Kenny an emerging defender. Buln ran rings around Longwarry last week. It has no key forwards but so many options with 14 individual goal kickers. Coach Bob McCallum (5 goal last week) has the luxury of playing out of the goal square due to his evergreen tall team mate Matt Gray still producing the goods around the ground. Such is their depth its lesser lights Reece Campbell, Jackson Kos and youngster Lachlan Axford are all to name just a few of many valuable contributors and the return of Mitch Nobelius from Warragul has added a nuggetty presence around the packs.

ELLINBANK v POOWONG

On form the Eagles at home should pull rank over the Magpies. It did make heavy weather of beating Nyora last Saturday but is undefeated at home. Captain Mick Urie is not a renowned goal kicker but snared five six-pointers last week while ex Warragul Industrials midfielder Michael Ablett was a new addition and did well after crossing just before the clearance window shut. Youngsters Ryan Atherton, Bryce Joyce and Rylan Smith are bona-fide super consistent defenders. Missing the experience of Will Jolley, Keegan Bott, Ben Wragg, Tom Johnson and Liam Anderson last week suggests it will only get better. Poowong's chances cannot be brushed aside lightly as it performed respectably against Buln Buln and Neerim South over the last month. Led by Jack Hazendonk, Mitch Van't Hoff, Tom Robertson and emerging forward Alex Henshall it has a ton of grit but a win this Saturday looks a bridge to far.

LANG LANG v CATANI

Over the last decade these two teams had many an interesting tussles and there is often an upset. Lang Lang kept its top five prospects with a win at Darnum last week but will need to improve for it battled to put the wooden spooners away. This is a real danger game for the home side as Catani pushed Trafalgar all the way last week. The Blues have a crack every

week but simply lack quality players in attack and defence. Lachlan Gregson notched 4 goals last Saturday and showed the form that made him a prolific goal kicker at junior level but has been asked to play all over the field this season since his return to the club from Tooradin. The Tigers kicked 17 goals against Catani in round 3 but since then has only kicked more than 10 goals once. Midfield recruits Daniel Reid, Dylan Gallasch and Kalin Parker have all made their mark, but the Tigers badly need Sean Dwyer back if it is to trouble the better sides.

LONGWARRY v NYORA

The Crows flopped last week. It is no disgrace to lose to Buln Buln but the margin – 136 points – was not acceptable. Its finals chances are now remote if not gone. Its younger brigade Cooper Brown, Fintan Fox and Liam Kirkman have all shown plenty as has Jed Serong and Luke Clarkson and Angus Young who deserve honourable mentions in recent weeks but to many others are performing below par. Nyora has not won a game since round 8 but last week shook off its poor form when it came close to causing the upset of the season when it got within 8 points of Ellinbank. Scott Pugh (21 goals) and ruckman Travis Stewart (15) when he moves forward have proved to be good targets, but its forwards are starved of opportunities. This is a 50/50 game, but I'll back Longwarry to bounce back due to home ground advantage.

YARRAGON v NILMA DARNUM

After the Panthers round 13 loss at Lang Lang it can kiss their top five hopes goodbye. Week by week it is one step forward followed by two steps back for them. New coach Jordan Wyatt must be frustrated its individual efforts have not reflected in output on the scoreboard. Yarragon is reasonably good at defending but lack firepower in attack. The Bombers put in a plucky effort last week to only go down by 8 points to Lang Lang. Its zero and 13 win-loss record doesn't reflect the steps forward it has made for it came off a very low base. With an eye to the future, it blooded U16s Kade Rossborough and Darcy Britt over the last fortnight who both showed they have a bright future. Fitzroy Stars recruit John Hayes with 17 goals has proved a handful for many opposition clubs but has only played six matches. At home and based on the fact Nyora concede far more points in defence than the Panthers the home side to win.
