

Round 16 Preview - Football

Round 16 of the Parklea EDFNL season is spread over Saturday and Sunday. The marquee match on Saturday will feature Trafalgar and Poowong and a crucial match for both teams. On Sunday Nilma Darnum host Catani and will go into the game with a real air of expectancy that it can open its winning account for it is a big day for the club with the appearance of Nathan Buckley in a Bombers jumper. It goes without saying 'Buck's' is one of the most decorated AFL players of all time – 280 matches, a Norm Smith medal in 2002, Brownlow medal in 2003, 6-time Copeland Trophy winner and 7 time All Australian. Sunday's match will be broadcast by SEN track 91.9fm.

TRAFALGAR v POOWONG

The Bloods will be looking to consolidate 3rd spot on the ladder on a big day for the club when it hosts its annual past players and officials' day while Poowong will be out to defend its 5th spot on the ladder. Trafalgar's high standing is largely due to the consistency of ruckman Dylan Farrell, utility Jace Butler, defenders Mitch Virtue and Hardy Kenny along with the arrival of mature recruits Daniel Baker and Curtis Barker (21 goals). Poowong has suffered successive loses to Neerim South and Ellinbank to put its top five prospects in jeopardy. It's experienced trio of defender Andrew Logan, midfielder Steven McInnes and ruckman Conor Cunningham will no doubt deliver the goods again in a match that shapes as a line ball call. Home ground advantage swings the result the way of Trafalgar.

LANG LANG v NYORA

With five wins in its last six matches the Tigers are mounting a strong challenge to displace Poowong in fifth position on the ladder. Karingal recruit Chaise Jordan (27 goals) has proved an astute pick up, Josh Brown and Brad Harding both responsible both for a lot of grunt around the packs this season will be pleased star midfielder Sean Dwyer returned for his first match for the season last week. Nyora has teased its fans this year. Shown a fair bit in patches but has not won a match since round 8. Coach Dylan Heylen remains the heartbeat of the team, Jordan Anderson, Jack Rosenow, forward Scott Pugh and newcomers Rhys Grange-Lylak and Conner Thompson are all goers in a team that has struggled break the lines this season against the better sides. Lang Lang is on a roll and wins.

LONGWARRY v NEERIM NEERIM SOUTH

Statistically the Crows can still make the top five but on form it is unlikely. It was plucky last week to comfortably account for Nyora after four late withdrawals which presented an opportunity for emerging 15-year-old Tyler Van Der Heyden

to make his debut and play alongside his father Paul Williams – a rare feat in the football world. Tyler kicked two goals and did not look out of place at senior level but this week if the selection committee opt to retain him is a whole different ball game. Neerim South will be fresh from the bye and will have a 'take no prisoners' approach in the last five rounds as it seeks a top three berth. After the Cats smashed Longwarry by 139 points in round 6 it hard to imagine the home team pose a significant threat.

YARRAGON v BULN BULN

The Panthers look a far better team this year, but it has not been reflected on the ladder. Put simply, it has a lot of honest toilers but a lack of match winners. Travis Davis, Lachie Devine, captain Tyler Payroli and Zac Hogton are never far away from the action, but others must step up if it is to prove competitive against the ladder leaders. Aside from a one-point loss to Ellinbank in round 13 it is hard to fault Buln Buln. It boasts a tight defence, hungry midfield and an improved forward line. Hayden Baker (31 goals) has plenty of support this season from Bob McCallum (20), Matt Gray (17), Riley Rundell (15) and Mitch Nobelius (14) the later two who joined the club over summer.

NILMA DARNUM v CATANI

This match looks likely to go down to the wire. It pits the 10th and 11th on the ladder. However, both have improved this season. Last year the Bombers had a % of 16 and this year it is 45 while Catani had a % of 28 last year and this year it is 66. Courtesy of 'The Carlton Draft' the appearance of former AFL Star Nathan Buckley will create huge interest and draw a big crowd and the Bombers will be up and about to leverage off the vibe. If the reports are on the money Buckley is likely to play out of the square rather than through the middle. Expect Sage Tapner, Nathan Campbell and ruckman Nick Carrigy to be among those that will provide him with good feed. Catani will miss its captain Dylan Williams (broken clavicle) but with pre-season recruits in Ryan Cunningham, Tyson Robinson, Tom Carpenter, Tom Robinson and Mitchell Latimer it may be a tad too strong.






