

## Round 17 Preview - Football

Most talk this week will surround Neerim Neerim South's home ground clash against Ellinbank. The Cats enter the match in 4th place and while their season is not at a critical juncture a loss would see it may need to win its last three matches to snaffle a top three finish - important to guarantee a double chance. A win will see it displace Trafalgar in the top three. The 91.9FM broadcast team will head to Poowong where the home side will be out to overturn a three-game losing streak against Longwarry.

### NEERIM NEERIM SOUTH v ELLINBANK

Neerim South is usually in a merciless mood at home but will need to steel itself for a real fight this Saturday. It is hard to understand how a team with four of the top 10 goal kickers in the league - Luke Kinder, Lachlan Bambridge, Chris Urie and Tom Crole is not inside the top three. To cut them some slack it was denied a win against Yarragon in the round 9 match that was called off before half time and declared a draw. Last week it shoved aside Longwarry with contempt. Youngster Adam Ramm is now an important cog in the Cat midfield and likewise Bunyip recruit Jack Blakey.

The Eagles are ticking along nicely. Since an unexpected round 9 loss at Lang Lang it has now won six on the bounce which includes inflicting a defeat upon ladder leaders Buln Buln and their only loss of the season. The return of Adam Cook (4 goals) in round 15 before last week's bye provides the Bankers with a key target while it also boasts the most miserly defence in no small way due to the resistance and ball winning ability of Ryan Atherton, Bryce Joyce and Rylan Smith. Their contest against the four-pronged Cat attack will shape the match. Neerim South is almost untouchable at home and to win in a nail biter.

### BULN BULN v LANG LANG

The Lyrebirds performed a demolition job on Yarragon last week. Hayden Baker (6 goals) and 37 for the year is a real predator around the big sticks but the most impressive aspect of the win was 12 individual goal kickers. Only the one loss and a % of 250 says it all. With an average winning margin of 66 points this season at home the visitors have a big job in front of it. Tiger coach Daniel Fry has rekindled confidence in his charges who have won six of their last seven matches. It will be out for redemption after losing to Buln Buln by 28 points in round 5. Lachlan Barwick displayed his versatility again last Saturday to pop up with 4 goals to follow the 5 he kicked in round 10 against Longwarry. Expect Lang Lang to receive a reality check.

### POOWONG v LONGWARRY

The Magpies have lost three on the trot. Their losses to Neerim South and Ellinbank were respectable but last week's 94-point loss at Trafalgar suggests it is now feeling the pinch of a long season. Their effort was so uncharacteristic. It could extract little if anything from last Saturday and must simply put that loss behind it and reset. Longwarry bowed out of any slim hope of a finals berth when it was crushed by Neerim South last Saturday. It was always going to be a development season for the Crows which has got good game time into its promising up and comers Liam Kirkman, Harry Colvin, Fintan Fox, Cooper Brown and Tyler Van Der Heyden.

### CATANI v YARRAGON

The Blues had to come from behind to beat cellar dwellers Nilma Darnum who were up and about in the Sunday match due to the presence of Nathan Buckley - who unfortunately only lasted 10 minutes after injuring his groin in the warmup. Nonetheless Catani did show resilience to get the job done. Jason Williams led by example with three goals while Nar Nar Goon recruit Jalen Atkins also impressed with three goals as did veteran Tom Keily, who has shown to be adept at both ends this season. Yarragon's performance last week against Buln Buln is best forgotten. A solitary goal and only three scoring shots in a home game. Daresay its worst effort since it joined the league. It was missing a few players however its performance would not measure up to any indicators set by the inner sanctum. The Panthers need to lift this week to gain respect. At home Catani and on a big day with its past players and officials celebrating 100 years as a club the home side to win.
